## AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal, 2 special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates, 3 primary and election expenses and election contests; creating 4 and defining membership of county boards of elections; 5 imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth, 6 7 courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners; imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying, 8 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to 9 10 elections," in dates of elections and primaries and special 11 elections, further providing for affidavits of candidates; 12 and, in nomination of candidates, further providing for 13 affidavits of candidates. 14
- 15 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 16 hereby enacts as follows:
- 17 Section 1. Sections 630.1, 910 and 981.1 of the act of June
- 18 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the Pennsylvania Election
- 19 Code, amended May 12, 2006 (P.L.178, No.45), are amended to
- 20 read:
- 21 Section 630.1. Affidavits of Candidates. -- Each candidate for
- 22 any State, county, city, borough, incorporated town, township,

- 1 school district or poor district office, or for the office of
- 2 United States Senator or Representative in Congress, selected as
- 3 provided in section 630 of this act, shall file with the
- 4 nomination certificate an affidavit stating--(a) his residence,
- 5 with street and number, if any, and his post-office address; (b)
- 6 his election district, giving city, borough, town or township;
- 7 (c) the name of the office for which he consents to be a
- 8 candidate; (d) that he is eliqible for such office; (e) that he
- 9 will not knowingly violate any provision of this act, or of any
- 10 law regulating and limiting election expenses and prohibiting
- 11 corrupt practices in connection therewith; (f) unless he is a
- 12 candidate for judge of a court of common pleas, the Philadelphia
- 13 Municipal Court or the Traffic Court of Philadelphia, or for the
- 14 office of school board in a district where that office is
- 15 elective or for the office of justice of the peace, that he is
- 16 not a candidate for the same office of any party or political
- 17 body other than the one designated in such certificate; (g) that
- 18 he is aware of the provisions of section 1626 of this act
- 19 requiring election and post-election reporting of campaign
- 20 contributions and expenditures; [and] (h) that he is not a
- 21 candidate for an office which he already holds, the term of
- 22 which is not set to expire in the same year as the office
- 23 subject to the affidavit[.]; and (i) unless he is a candidate
- 24 for Federal office, that he has not been convicted of
- 25 <u>embezzlement of public moneys, bribery, perjury or other</u>
- 26 infamous crime.
- 27 Section 910. Affidavits of Candidates. -- Each candidate for
- 28 any State, county, city, borough, incorporated town, township,
- 29 ward, school district, poor district, election district, party
- 30 office, party delegate or alternate, or for the office of United

- 1 States Senator or Representative in Congress, shall file with
- 2 his nomination petition his affidavit stating--(a) his
- 3 residence, with street and number, if any, and his post-office
- 4 address; (b) his election district, giving city, borough, town
- 5 or township; (c) the name of the office for which he consents to
- 6 be a candidate; (d) that he is eligible for such office; (e)
- 7 that he will not knowingly violate any provision of this act, or
- 8 of any law regulating and limiting nomination and election
- 9 expenses and prohibiting corrupt practices in connection
- 10 therewith; (f) unless he is a candidate for judge of a court of
- 11 common pleas, the Philadelphia Municipal Court or the Traffic
- 12 Court of Philadelphia, or for the office of school director in a
- 13 district where that office is elective or for the office of
- 14 justice of the peace that he is not a candidate for nomination
- 15 for the same office of any party other than the one designated
- 16 in such petition; (g) if he is a candidate for a delegate, or
- 17 alternate delegate, member of State committee, National
- 18 committee or party officer, that he is a registered and enrolled
- 19 member of the designated party; (h) if he is a candidate for
- 20 delegate or alternate delegate the presidential candidate to
- 21 whom he is committed or the term "uncommitted"; (i) that he is
- 22 aware of the provisions of section 1626 of this act requiring
- 23 pre-election and post-election reporting of campaign
- 24 contributions and expenditures; [and] (j) that he is not a
- 25 candidate for an office which he already holds, the term of
- 26 which is not set to expire in the same year as the office
- 27 subject to the affidavit[.]; and (k) unless he is a candidate
- 28 for Federal office, that he has not been convicted of
- 29 embezzlement of public moneys, bribery, perjury or other
- 30 infamous crime. In cases of petitions for delegate and alternate

- 1 delegate to National conventions, the candidate's affidavit
- 2 shall state that his signature to the delegate's statement, as
- 3 hereinafter set forth, if such statement is signed by said
- 4 candidate, was affixed to the sheet or sheets of said petition
- 5 prior to the circulation of same. In the case of a candidate for
- 6 nomination as President of the United States, it shall not be
- 7 necessary for such candidate to file the affidavit required in
- 8 this section to be filed by candidates, but the post-office
- 9 address of such candidate shall be stated in such nomination
- 10 petition.
- 11 Section 981.1. Affidavits of Candidates. -- Each candidate for
- 12 any State, county, city, borough, incorporated town, township,
- 13 ward, school district, poor district or election district
- 14 office, or for the office of United States Senator or
- 15 Representative in Congress, selected as provided in sections 979
- 16 and 980 of this act, shall file with the substituted nomination
- 17 certificate an affidavit stating--(a) his residence, with street
- 18 and number, if any, and his post-office address; (b) his
- 19 election district, giving city, borough, town or township; (c)
- 20 the name of the office for which he consents to be a candidate;
- 21 (d) that he is eligible for such office; (e) that he will not
- 22 knowingly violate any provision of this act, or of any law
- 23 regulating and limiting election expenses and prohibiting
- 24 corrupt practices in connection therewith; (f) unless he is a
- 25 candidate for judge of a court of common pleas, the Philadelphia
- 26 Municipal Court or the Traffic Court of Philadelphia, or for the
- 27 office of school board in a district where that office is
- 28 elective or for the office of justice of the peace, that he is
- 29 not a candidate for the same office of any party or political
- 30 body other than the one designated in such certificate; (g) that

- 1 he is aware of the provisions of section 1626 of this act
- 2 requiring election and post-election reporting of campaign
- 3 contributions and expenditures; [and] (h) that he is not a
- 4 candidate for an office which he already holds, the term of
- 5 which is not set to expire in the same year as the office
- 6 subject to the affidavit[.]; and (i) unless he is a candidate
- 7 for Federal office, that he has not been convicted of
- 8 <u>embezzlement of public moneys</u>, bribery, perjury or other
- 9 infamous crime.
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
