AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 2 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the 3 Executive Department thereof and the administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 5 6 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 7 8 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 9 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 10 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 12 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 13 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 14 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 15 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 16 and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the 17 18 number and compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 19 commissions shall be determined," in powers and duties of the 20 Department of Human Services and its departmental 21 22 administrative and advisory boards and commissions, providing for housing for mentally ill inmates of county correctional 23 24 institutions.

- 26 hereby enacts as follows:
- 27 Section 1. The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known
- 28 as The Administrative Code of 1929, is amended by adding a

- 2 <u>Section 2336. Housing for Mentally Ill Inmates of County</u>
- 3 <u>Correctional Institutions.--The Department of Human Services</u>
- 4 shall construct and operate an appropriate facility for mentally
- 5 <u>ill inmates of county correctional institutions who are unable</u>
- 6 to be accommodated at an existing State mental health facility.
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
