AN ACT

Amending Title 25 (Elections) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in voter registration, further providing for methods of voter registration, providing for electronic voter 3 registration application and for electronic submission of 4 changes to registration and further providing for preparation 5 and distribution of applications; in changes in records, 7 further providing for change of enrollment of political party; in penalties, further providing for altering 8 registration; and conferring powers and imposing duties on 9 the Department of State. 10 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 12 hereby enacts as follows: 13 Section 1. Section 1321 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania 14 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read: 15 § 1321. Methods of voter registration. 16 An individual qualified to register to vote under section 17 1301(a) (relating to qualifications to register) may apply to 18 register as follows: * * * 19 20 (5) Under section 1325.1 (relating to electronic voter

- 1 <u>registration application).</u>
- 2 Section 2. Title 25 is amended by adding sections to read:
- 3 § 1325.1. Electronic voter registration application.
- 4 (a) Submission. -- An application to register to vote may be
- 5 submitted by an electronic voter registration application on the
- 6 <u>Internet website of the department in the manner provided under</u>
- 7 this section.
- 8 (b) Establishment.--The department shall develop an
- 9 <u>electronic voter application within 90 days of the effective</u>
- 10 date of this section. The electronic voter application may not
- 11 be put into use until the department, the Department of
- 12 <u>Transportation and each commission have developed a process and</u>
- 13 the infrastructure necessary for the effective use of the
- 14 application as contemplated by this section. The electronic
- 15 voter registration application shall comply with the
- 16 requirements under section 1327 (relating to preparation and
- 17 distribution of applications). The applicant shall enter the
- 18 <u>data requested on the electronic voter registration application</u>
- 19 and affirmatively attest to the truth of the information being
- 20 provided by the applicant. Once submitted by the applicant, the
- 21 department shall obtain an electronic copy of the applicant's
- 22 <u>signature from the applicant's driver's license or the</u>
- 23 applicant's identification card issued by the Department of
- 24 Transportation under 75 Pa.C.S. § 1510(b) (relating to issuance
- 25 and content of driver's license) and transfer the application to
- 26 the SURE system. If the department determines that a signature
- 27 <u>is not in the database of the Department of Transportation, the</u>
- 28 department shall print and mail the completed voter registration
- 29 application to the applicant with instructions to sign and mail
- 30 the application to the appropriate commission. Use of the

- 1 <u>electronic voter registration application by the applicant shall</u>
- 2 constitute the applicant's consent to the use of the applicant's
- 3 signature on the applicant's driver's license or identification
- 4 <u>card for voter registration purposes.</u>
- 5 (c) Duties of department. -- The following shall apply:
- 6 (1) Within 24 months following the effective date of
- 7 this subsection, the department shall promulgate regulations
- 8 <u>necessary to implement the provisions of this section and</u>
- 9 section 1325.2 (relating to electronic submission of changes
- 10 to registration). Prior to the promulgation, the department
- 11 <u>shall publish implementation guidelines as a notice in the</u>
- 12 <u>Pennsylvania Bulletin.</u>
- 13 (2) The department shall develop and employ security
- 14 <u>measures to ensure the security and integrity of registration</u>
- 15 <u>applications and change registration applications submitted</u>
- electronically under this section and section 1325.2.
- 17 (d) Time. -- Voter registration under this section may be made
- 18 at any time. If an electronic voter registration application is
- 19 submitted later than 30 days before an election, the application
- 20 shall be retained by the department and transferred to the SURE
- 21 system as soon as practicable following the election.
- 22 § 1325.2. Electronic submission of changes to registration.
- 23 (a) Changing information. -- A registered elector may change
- 24 information in the elector's voter registration records by using
- 25 the electronic voter registration application developed by the
- 26 department under section 1325.1 (relating to electronic voter
- 27 <u>registration application</u>) or a form developed by the department
- 28 for the changes, as determined by the department. The changes
- 29 that may be made electronically are as follows:
- 30 (1) A change in the enrollment of political designation.

- 1 (2) The enrollment of a political designation if,
- 2 <u>although registered</u>, the elector has not previously enrolled
- 3 <u>as a member of a party.</u>
- 4 <u>(3) The registered elector's name.</u>
- 5 <u>(4) The registered elector's address.</u>
- 6 (b) Submission. -- The provisions of section 1325.1 regarding
- 7 the truth of the information, use of the elector's signature on
- 8 <u>file with the Department of Transportation and other</u>
- 9 <u>verification</u> by the elector of the elector's identity shall
- 10 apply to a submission for a change to the elector's registration
- 11 records under this section. Use by a registered elector of an
- 12 <u>electronic voter registration application or other form</u>
- 13 <u>developed by the department under subsection (a) for changes to</u>
- 14 the elector's registration records shall constitute the
- 15 <u>elector's consent to the use of the elector's signature on the</u>
- 16 <u>elector's driver's license or identification card for the</u>
- 17 purposes of making the changes.
- 18 Section 3. Sections 1327(a)(3) and (4) and (b)(3), 1503 and
- 19 1704(a) of Title 25 are amended to read:
- 20 § 1327. Preparation and distribution of applications.
- 21 (a) Form. --
- 22 * * *
- 23 (3) Any person who assists in the completion of the
- registration application shall sign or, in the case of
- 25 <u>registration under section 1325.1 (relating to electronic</u>
- voter registration application), electronically sign the
- application and indicate the person's address. In the case of
- 28 those registering under sections 1323 (relating to
- 29 application with driver's license application) and 1325
- 30 (relating to government agencies), the person providing

- assistance shall insert the person's initials or employee or agent identification number on a separate or detachable portion of the application or computer data file.
 - registration application under section 1325.1, shall be printed on stock of good quality and shall be of suitable uniform size. [Nothing in this part shall prohibit the design and use of an electronic voter registration application which includes the applicant's digitized or electronic signature.]

 The registration application, including a registration application under section 1325.1, shall contain the following information; however, the information may be provided on a separate form for voter registration made under section 1323 or 1325:
 - (i) Notice that a registered elector does not need to reregister unless the registered elector has moved.
 - (ii) Instructions on how to fill out and submit the application and notification of when the application must be submitted to a voter registration office or, for registration under section 1325.1, electronically in order to be registered for the ensuing election.
 - (iii) Notice that the applicant must be a citizen of the United States for at least one month prior to the next election and a resident of this Commonwealth and the election district for at least 30 days and must be at least 18 years of age by the day of the next ensuing election and has not been confined in a penal institution for a conviction of a felony within the last five years. The notice required in this subparagraph shall be in print identical to the declaration under subsection (b).

- 1 (iv) Notice that political party enrollment is
 2 mandatory to vote in a primary election of a political
 3 party.
 - (v) Notice that the commission will mail by nonforwardable mail to the applicant a voter's identification card upon acceptance of the application and that the applicant should contact the commission if the identification card is not received within 14 days from the date the application is sent to the registration office or submitted electronically to the department under section 1325.1.
 - (vi) Notice that registration is not complete until the application is processed and accepted by the commission or the department if submitted electronically under section 1325.1.
 - (vii) A warning to the applicant that making a false registration or furnishing false information is perjury. The notice required in this subparagraph shall be in print identical to the declaration under subsection (b).
 - (viii) Instructions to Federal or State employees who wish to retain voting residence in county of last residence to so indicate on the application.
 - (ix) Notice that, if an individual declines to register to vote, the fact that the individual has declined to register will remain confidential and will be used only for voter registration purposes. The notice required in this subparagraph shall be in print identical to the declaration under subsection (b).
 - (x) Notice that, if an individual does register to vote, the office at which the individual submits a voter

registration application will remain confidential and will be used for voter registration purposes only. The

notices required in this subparagraph shall be in print

6 (b) Registration declaration. --

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(3) The registration declaration shall contain the printed name [and signature of the applicant and the date of signing], date of signing and, except for applicants submitting a registration under section 1325.1, the signature of the applicant. An applicant unable to sign the voter registration application shall make a mark before a person of the applicant's choice other than the applicant's employer or an agent of the applicant's union. The person shall insert the person's name, address and telephone number. If the person is an employee or agent of the Department of Transportation or another agency as provided under section 1325 and is assisting the applicant in an official capacity, the employee or agent shall insert the initials and identification number of the employee or agent. In the case of applicants registering under section 1323 or 1325, the person providing assistance shall insert initials or employee or agent identification number on a separate or detachable portion of the application or computer data file. In the case of an applicant registering under section 1325.1, the applicant shall be required to verify the applicant's identity by:

(i) providing the last four digits of the

- 6 § 1503. Change of enrollment of political party.
- 7 By the deadline for registration, a registered elector who
- 8 desires to change the enrollment of political designation or
- 9 who, although registered, has not previously enrolled as a
- 10 member of a party may appear before a commissioner, registrar or
- 11 clerk or may submit an application by mail under section 1324
- 12 (relating to application by mail) [and state in a signed] or
- 13 <u>electronically under section 1325.2 (relating to electronic</u>
- 14 submission of changes to registration). In cases other than
- 15 submission under section 1325.2, the elector shall state in a
- 16 <u>signed</u> writing the political party in which the registered
- 17 elector desires to be enrolled. If the signature of the elector
- 18 is verified by comparison with the registered elector's
- 19 signature as it appears on file with the commission, the
- 20 commissioner, registrar or clerk shall make the change in its
- 21 registration records. [If] In cases other than submission under
- 22 <u>section 1325.2, if</u> supported by other evidence of identity, a
- 23 mark may be made in lieu of a signature by a registered elector
- 24 who is unable to write. The mark must be made in the presence of
- 25 a witness who must sign the registration application. For
- 26 submissions under section 1325.2, the elector shall follow the
- 27 procedure for verification of the elector's identity set forth
- 28 in section 1325.1 (relating to electronic voter registration
- 29 <u>application</u>).
- 30 § 1704. Altering registration.

- 1 (a) Prohibition. -- No registrar, commissioner, clerk or
- 2 assistant [or] commission employee or other individual may do
- 3 any of the following:
- 4 (1) Intentionally insert or permit to be inserted an
- 5 entry in a registration record without a proper application
- 6 under this part or without requiring the proper evidence of
- 7 the right of the applicant to be registered.
- 8 (2) Intentionally materially alter a registration record
- 9 after the entries have been made unless the alteration is in
- 10 accordance with this part. This paragraph does not apply to
- an alteration pursuant to an order of a court of common pleas
- 12 or of a commission.
- 13 (3) Intentionally submit false information regarding a
- change of party enrollment or name or address on a
- registration record of another individual.

- 17 Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
