AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," in terms and courses of study,
- 6 providing for a tutoring program.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 Section 1528. Tutoring Program. -- (a) The State Board of
- 13 Education shall, by regulation, establish a tutoring program
- 14 whereby pupils in grades eleven and twelve may tutor pupils in
- 15 grades one through six. These regulations shall, at a minimum,
- 16 provide for the following:
- 17 <u>(1) The qualifications of pupils eligible to serve as</u>
- 18 <u>tutors</u>.
- 19 (2) The qualifications of pupils eligible for tutoring.

- 1 (3) That participating tutors receive academic credits for
- 2 these services.
- 3 (4) That, in addition to clause (1), quidelines be
- 4 <u>established to encourage eleventh and twelfth grade pupils who</u>
- 5 are not meeting their academic potential to volunteer for the
- 6 program as tutors if it is determined that their serving as
- 7 tutors could improve their own academic performance.
- 8 (b) This program shall apply to each school district in this
- 9 Commonwealth.
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
