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AN ACT

1 Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, in hunting and furtaking licenses, further  
3 providing for nonresidents.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 2703 of Title 34 of the Pennsylvania  
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 2703. Nonresidents.

9 (a) General rule.--For the purpose of this title, any person  
10 unable to meet the requirements of section 2702 (relating to  
11 residents) shall be a nonresident.

12 (b) Nonresident full-time student annual licenses.--

13 (1) For the purposes of this chapter, any person who  
14 does not purchase a resident license is eligible for a  
15 nonresident full-time student license when the person:

16 (i) Is a nonresident and full-time student enrolled  
17 at a high school, technical school, college or university  
18 in this Commonwealth at least 30 days prior to submission

1 of the application under subparagraph (ii).

2 (ii) Has applied to an issuing agent or to the  
3 commission and has provided a valid student  
4 identification card or other written proof of the  
5 enrollment.

6 (iii) Has paid the issuing agent or the commission a  
7 license fee and issuing agent fee, the amount of which  
8 shall be equal to that paid by a resident applying for  
9 the same type of license.

10 (2) The spouse or dependent of a person who obtains a  
11 license under paragraph (1) may purchase the same license  
12 when the spouse or dependent complies with paragraph (1)(ii)  
13 and (iii).

14 (3) The license purchased under this subsection shall be  
15 revoked if the person or the person's spouse or parent:

16 (i) is no longer a nonresident and full-time student  
17 enrolled at a high school, technical school, college or  
18 university in this Commonwealth during the term of the  
19 license; or

20 (ii) establishes domicile in and obtains any  
21 privilege or entitlement conditional on residency from  
22 another state.

23 Section 2. This act shall apply to applications for licenses  
24 submitted in any license year commencing after the effective  
25 date of this section.

26 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
