## AN ACT

Amending Title 62 (Procurement) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in contract clauses and preference provisions, requiring Commonwealth agencies to procure flags that are 3 manufactured in the United States and to give preference to 4 5 American-made products; and imposing a penalty. 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 7 8 Section 1. Chapter 37 of Title 62 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subchapter to read: 10 SUBCHAPTER F 11 FLAG PROCUREMENT AND 12 AMERICAN-MADE PRODUCT PREFERENCE 13 Sec. 14 3761. 3764. Contract provisions.

- 1 <u>3765</u>. Payment under contract and recovery of payments.
- 2 <u>3766</u>. Penalty.
- 3 § 3761. Short title of subchapter.
- 4 This subchapter shall be known and may be cited as the Flag
- 5 <u>Procurement and American-made Product Preference Act.</u>
- 6 § 3762. Legislative findings and declaration.
- 7 (a) Findings. -- It is hereby determined by the General
- 8 Assembly that:
- 9 <u>(1) The production of flags and other American-made</u>
- 10 products provide jobs and family incomes for residents of
- this Commonwealth.
- 12 (2) It has, for many years, been the policy of the
- 13 <u>Commonwealth to aid and support the development and expansion</u>
- 14 of industry in this Commonwealth in order to foster the
- economic well-being of the Commonwealth and its people.
- 16 (3) The economy and general welfare of the Commonwealth
- and its people, as well as the economy and general welfare of
- 18 the United States, are related to the preservation and
- 19 development of industry in this Commonwealth and in the other
- 20 states of the United States.
- 21 (b) Declaration. -- The General Assembly declares that the
- 22 Commonwealth and all government agencies should, at all times,
- 23 aid and promote the development of the flag industry of the
- 24 United States in order to stimulate and improve the economic
- 25 well-being of the Commonwealth and its people and give
- 26 preference to American-made products when they are similarly
- 27 priced and of similar value and similar usefulness.
- 28 § 3763. Definitions.
- The following words and phrases when used in this subchapter
- 30 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the

- 1 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 2 <u>"Flag." Any of the following:</u>
- 3 (1) The flag of the United States, as defined in 4
- 4 <u>U.S.C.</u> § 1 (relating to flag; stripes and stars on) and the
- 5 <u>executive orders entered in connection with that section</u>,
- 6 made of fabric, cloth or paper displayed from a staff or
- 7 <u>flagpole or in a window. The term does not include a</u>
- 8 <u>depiction or emblem of the United States flag made of lights</u>,
- 9 paint, roofing, siding, paving materials, flora or balloons
- or any other similar building, landscaping or decorative
- 11 <u>component.</u>
- 12 (2) The flag of the Commonwealth, as described in
- 13 <u>section 1 of the act of June 13, 1907 (P.L.560, No.373),</u>
- 14 <u>entitled "An act designating the official flag of the</u>
- 15 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and describing the same;
- providing for the carrying of such flag by the regiments of
- 17 the National Guard of Pennsylvania; authorizing the Secretary
- of the Commonwealth to provide, and have deposited in the
- office of Secretary of the Commonwealth, a model of said
- flag, and making an appropriation therefor."
- 21 "United States." The United States of America and all
- 22 territory, continental or insular, subject to the jurisdiction
- 23 of the United States.
- 24 § 3764. Contract provisions.
- 25 <u>(a) Flags.--All Commonwealth agencies and the General</u>
- 26 Assembly, its officers and agencies shall procure only flags
- 27 that are manufactured in the United States. A flag is
- 28 manufactured in the United States if the fabric, cloth or paper
- 29 is woven, dyed, printed or otherwise embedded into the final
- 30 product in the United States. Contract documents for the

- 1 procurement of flags shall contain a provision that the flags
- 2 procured by the Commonwealth agency shall be manufactured in the
- 3 United States.
- 4 (b) Other products. -- All Commonwealth agencies and the
- 5 General Assembly, its officers and agencies shall give
- 6 preference to American-made products when they are similarly
- 7 priced and of similar value and similar usefulness.
- 8 § 3765. Payment under contract and recovery of payments.
- 9 <u>A Commonwealth agency or the General Assembly, its officers</u>
- 10 and agencies may not authorize, provide for or make a payment to
- 11 <u>a person under a contract containing the provisions required by</u>
- 12 section 3764 (relating to contract provisions) unless the
- 13 Commonwealth agency or the General Assembly, its officers and
- 14 <u>agencies is satisfied that the person has complied with the</u>
- 15 provisions. If a Commonwealth agency or the General Assembly,
- 16 <u>its officers and agencies determines that a person who supplied</u>
- 17 flags to the agency violated section 3764, the agency may
- 18 recover from the person a payment made by the Commonwealth
- 19 agency or the General Assembly, its officers and agencies for
- 20 the flags.
- 21 § 3766. Penalty.
- 22 A person who willfully violates the provisions of this
- 23 subchapter may be prohibited by the Commonwealth agency or the
- 24 General Assembly, its officers and agencies from participation
- 25 in contracts awarded by the Commonwealth agency or the General
- 26 Assembly, its officers and agencies for a period of five years
- 27 from the date of the determination that a violation has
- 28 occurred. This penalty may be in addition to the withholding or
- 29 recovery of payments under section 3765 (relating to payment
- 30 under contract and recovery of payments).

- 1 Section 2. This act shall apply to the procurement of flags
- 2 or contracts for the procurement of flags or other products
- 3 under 62 Pa.C.S. § 3765 entered into on or after the effective
- 4 date of this section.
- 5 Section 3. All acts and parts of acts are repealed insofar
- 6 as they are inconsistent with this act.
- 7 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
