AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, in registration of vehicles, providing for special  
3 pediatric cancer research registration plate, and  
4 establishing The Pediatric Cancer Research Fund.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

9 § 1369.3. Pediatric Cancer research registration plate.

10 (a) Plate.--The department, in consultation with relevant  
11 stakeholders, shall design a special pediatric cancer research  
12 registration plate. Upon application of any person, accompanied  
13 by a fee of \$50, which shall be in addition to the annual  
14 registration fee, the department shall issue the plate for a  
15 passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight of not  
16 more than 14,000 pounds, or a motor home.

1     (b) Pediatric Cancer Research Fund.--The Pediatric Cancer  
2     Research Fund is established in the State Treasury. The fee  
3     collected by the department under this section shall be  
4     deposited in the fund. All money in the fund shall be allocated  
5     annually to institutions in this Commonwealth that conduct  
6     pediatric cancer research. The allocation of funds shall be  
7     equal among all pediatric cancer research institutions.

8     Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
