8	Section 1. Section 1 of the act of May 1, 1913 (P.L.155,									
9	No.104), referred to as the Separations Act, amended December									
10	22, 1981 (P.L.546, No.159), is amended to read:									
11	Section 1. <u>(a)</u> Be it enacted, &c., That hereafter in the									
12	preparation of specifications for the erection, construction,									
13	and alteration of any public building, when the entire cost of									
14	such work shall exceed [four thousand dollars] one hundred									
15	thousand dollars subject to annual adjustment under subsection									
16	(b), it shall be the duty of the architect, engineer, or other									
17	person preparing such specifications, to prepare separate									
18	specifications for the plumbing, heating, ventilating, and									
19	electrical work; and it shall be the duty of the person or									

1 persons authorized to enter into contracts for the erection,
2 construction, or alteration of such public buildings to receive
3 separate bids upon each of the said branches of work, and to
4 award the contract for the same to the lowest responsible bidder
5 for each of said branches.

Every contract for the construction, reconstruction, 6 7 alteration, repair, improvement or maintenance of public works 8 shall comply with the provisions of the act of March 3, 1978 9 (P.L.6, No.3), known as the "Steel Products Procurement Act." 10 (b) The Department of Labor and Industry shall adjust the amount at which competitive bidding is required in subsection 11 12 (a) on March 1 of each year to conform with increases or 13 decreases in the Consumer Price Index as published by the United 14 States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics for the previous calendar year for Urban Wage Earners in the combined 15 area of Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Delaware and Maryland. 16 17 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read: 18 Section 1.1. No person shall evade the provisions of section 19 1 by purchasing or contracting for services and personal properties piecemeal to obtain prices under the required 20 advertising price, subject to annual adjustment under section 21 22 1(b). This provision is intended to make unlawful the making of 23 a series of purchases or contracts each for less than the price 24 to which section 1 applies, or by making several simultaneous purchases or contracts, each below said price, when in either 25 26 case, the transactions involved should have been made as one transaction for one price. Any persons who violate this 27 provision, and who know that the transaction in question is or 28 29 ought to be a part of a larger transaction, and that it is being divided in order to evade the requirements of section 1, shall 30

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1	be	jointly	and	severally	sub	ject	to	surcharge	for	ten	per	centum	

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2 of the full amount of the contract or purchase.
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3 Section 3. This act shall apply to contracts and purchases
4 advertised on or after the effective date of this section.
5 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
