## AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An 1 act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public 2 welfare laws of the Commonwealth," in public assistance, 3 providing for payments for burial expenses; and abrogating 55 Pa. Code § 283.21. 5 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 1. Article IV of the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Public Welfare Code, is amended by adding a subarticle to read: 10 11 (n) Burial Services Allowance 12 Section 494. Payments for Burial Services. -- (a) The department shall pay a burial or cremation allowance in the 13 amount of nine hundred dollars (\$900) for the following 14 15 individuals:
- 16 (1) Those who received Supplemental Security Income.
- 17 (2) Those receiving cash benefits from the department prior
- 18 to death.
- (3) Those found eligible for cash assistance prior to death. 19

- 1 (4) Residents of nursing homes who received Supplemental\_
- 2 Security Income or nursing home care payments prior to and
- 3 continuously since January 1, 1973.
- 4 (b) This amount may be supplemented by the decedent's estate
- 5 or another party in an amount not to exceed nine hundred dollars
- 6 (\$900), in accordance with the eligibility requirements of 55
- 7 Pa. Code § 283.3 (relating to requirements for payment).
- 8 Individuals who die but have never sought assistance shall be
- 9 <u>reviewed for eligibility to qualify for a grant allowance. If</u>
- 10 <u>eligible</u>, an allowance shall be paid by the department.
- 11 (c) Separate payments totaling an amount not to exceed the
- 12 <u>amounts authorized in subsections (a) and (b) may be made for</u>
- 13 <u>funeral</u>, <u>cemetery</u> and <u>crematorium</u> <u>expenses</u>.
- 14 (d) The amounts specified in subsections (a) and (b) shall
- 15 <u>increase by fifty dollars (\$50) each year for five consecutive</u>
- 16 years after the effective date of this section.
- 17 Section 2. The provisions of 55 Pa. Code § 283.21 are
- 18 abrogated. All other provisions of 55 Pa. Code are abrogated
- 19 insofar as they are inconsistent with this act.
- 20 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
