AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in miscellaneous provisions, further providing for 2 the offenses of homicide by vehicle while driving under 3 influence and for aggravated assault by vehicle while driving 4 under the influence. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 7 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Sections 3735(a) and 3735.1(a) of Title 75 of the 8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: 10 § 3735. Homicide by vehicle while driving under influence. Offense defined .-- Any person who unintentionally causes 11 12 the death of another person as the result of a violation of 13 section 3802 (relating to driving under influence of alcohol or controlled substance) and who is convicted of violating section 14 15 3802 is guilty of [a] the following: 16 (1) A felony of the second degree when the violation is 17 the cause of death and the sentencing court shall order the

person to serve a minimum term of imprisonment of not less

than three years. A consecutive three-year term of

- 1 imprisonment shall be imposed for each victim whose death is
- 2 the result of the violation of section 3802.
- 3 (2) A misdemeanor of the second degree when the
- 4 <u>violation is not the cause of death and the sentencing court</u>
- 5 <u>shall impose a fine of not more than \$5,000.</u>

- 7 § 3735.1. Aggravated assault by vehicle while driving under the
- 8 influence.
- 9 (a) Offense defined. -- Any person who negligently causes
- 10 serious bodily injury to another person as the result of a
- 11 violation of section 3802 (relating to driving under influence
- 12 of alcohol or controlled substance) and who is convicted of
- 13 violating section 3802 commits [a] the following:
- 14 <u>(1) A</u> felony of the second degree when the violation is
- 15 the cause of the injury.
- 16 (2) A misdemeanor of the second degree when the
- violation is not the cause of the injury and the sentencing
- court shall impose a fine of not more than \$2,500.
