## AN ACT

- Designating a portion of Blair Mill Road in Montgomery County as the PVT William H. Walls, U.S.M.C. Memorial Highway.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. PVT William H. Walls, U.S.M.C. Memorial Highway.
- 6 (a) Findings. -- The General Assembly finds and declares as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (1) PVT William H. Walls, a native of Horsham Township,
- 9 Montgomery County, valiantly served in the Marine Corps
- 10 during the Vietnam Conflict.
- 11 (2) On January 24, 1966, PVT Walls, at 19 years of age,
- 12 gave his life in service to his country when he was mortally
- wounded by sniper fire in Quang Nam Province, Vietnam.
- 14 (b) Designation. -- The section of Blair Mill Road from
- 15 Moreland Road to Horsham Road in Upper Moreland Township and

- 1 Horsham Township, Montgomery County, is hereby designated the
- 2 PVT William H. Walls, U.S.M.C. Memorial Highway.
- 3 (c) Signs. -- The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 4 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to
- 5 traffic in both directions on the highway.
- 6 Section 2. Effective date.
- 7 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
