AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, IN GENERAL PROVISIONS, FURTHER PROVIDING FOR <--
3 DEFINITIONS; AND, IN CERTIFICATE OF TITLE AND SECURITY
4 INTERESTS, further providing for duration of perfection.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 1138(a) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania <--
8 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

9 SECTION 1. THE DEFINITION OF "RECREATIONAL TRAILER" IN <--
10 SECTION 102 OF TITLE 75 OF THE PENNSYLVANIA CONSOLIDATED
11 STATUTES IS AMENDED AND THE SECTION IS AMENDED BY ADDING A
12 DEFINITION TO READ:

13 § 102. DEFINITIONS.

14 SUBJECT TO ADDITIONAL DEFINITIONS CONTAINED IN SUBSEQUENT
15 PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE WHICH ARE APPLICABLE TO SPECIFIC
16 PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE, THE FOLLOWING WORDS AND PHRASES WHEN
17 USED IN THIS TITLE SHALL HAVE, UNLESS THE CONTEXT CLEARLY

1 INDICATES OTHERWISE, THE MEANINGS GIVEN TO THEM IN THIS SECTION:

3 "RECREATIONAL TRAILER." [A TRAILER DESIGNED OR ADAPTED AND
4 USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR RECREATIONAL PURPOSES.] A VEHICLE PRIMARILY
5 DESIGNED AS TEMPORARY LIVING QUARTERS FOR RECREATIONAL, CAMPING
6 OR TRAVEL USE, WHICH EITHER HAS ITS OWN POWER OR IS MOUNTED ON
7 OR DRAWN BY ANOTHER VEHICLE. THE TERM INCLUDES A TRAVEL TRAILER,
8 RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARK TRAILER, SLIDE-IN CAMPER, CAMPING
9 TRAILER AND MOTOR HOME.

10 "RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARK TRAILER." A VEHICLE THAT IS BUILT
11 ON A SINGLE CHASSIS MOUNTED ON WHEELS, HAS A GROSS TRAILER AREA
12 NOT EXCEEDING 400 SQUARE FEET IN THE SET-UP MODE AND IS
13 CERTIFIED BY THE MANUFACTURER AS COMPLYING WITH ANSI A119.5.

15 SECTION 2. SECTION 1138(A) OF TITLE 75 IS AMENDED TO READ:

16 § 1138. Duration of perfection.

17 (a) General rule.--Perfection of a security interest is
18 effective for a period of 30 years in the case of a mobile home
19 or emergency vehicle, 20 years for a motor home or recreational
20 trailer, eight years in the case of a truck tractor or trailer
21 weighing in excess of 10,000 pounds and six years in all other
22 cases, in each case dating from the time of perfection as
23 provided for in this subchapter and subject to renewal as
24 provided in subsection (b).
