AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled
 2 "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal,
 3 special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates,
 4 primary and election expenses and election contests; creating
 5 and defining membership of county boards of elections;
 6 imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth,
 7 courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners;
 8 imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying,
 9 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and
 10 repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to
 11 elections," further providing for district election officers.

12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
 13 hereby enacts as follows:

14 Section 1. Section 412.2(a) of the act of June 3, 1937
 15 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the Pennsylvania Election Code,
 16 amended May 12, 2006 (P.L.178, No.45), is amended and the
 17 section is amended by adding a subsection to read:

18 Section 412.2. Compensation of District Election Officers.--

19 (a) In all counties [regardless of class], except for counties
 20 of the first class, the compensation of judges of election,
 21 inspectors of election, clerks and machine operators shall be

1 fixed by the county board of elections for each election in
2 accordance with the following:

3 Election Officers	4 Minimum	5 Maximum
	6 Compensation	7 Compensation
8 Judges of election	\$75	\$200
9 Inspectors of election	\$75	\$195
10 Clerks and machine operators	\$70	\$195

11 (a.1) In counties of the first class, the compensation of
12 judges of election, inspectors of election, clerks and machine
13 operators shall be established at the discretion of the county
14 board of elections under subsection (c) or shall be fixed by the
15 county board of elections for each election in accordance with
16 the following, whichever is greater:

14 <u>Election Officers</u>	15 <u>Hourly Wage</u>
16 <u>Judges of election</u>	<u>\$17 per hour</u>
17 <u>Inspectors of election</u>	<u>\$16 per hour</u>
18 <u>Clerks and machine operators</u>	<u>\$15 per hour</u>

20 Section 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2016, or
immediately, whichever is later.
