AN ACT

- Amending the act of October 6, 1998 (P.L.705, No.92), entitled, 1 as amended, "An act providing for the creation of keystone opportunity zones and keystone opportunity expansion zones to foster economic opportunities in this Commonwealth, to facilitate economic development, stimulate industrial, 5 commercial and residential improvements and prevent physical 6 and infrastructure deterioration of geographic areas within 7 this Commonwealth; authorizing expenditures; providing tax exemptions, tax deductions, tax abatements and tax credits; 9 creating additional obligations of the Commonwealth and local 10 governmental units; and prescribing powers and duties of 11 certain State and local departments, agencies and officials," 12 in procedures for zones, providing for prevailing wages. 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 14 15 hereby enacts as follows: 16 Section 1. The act of October 6, 1998 (P.L.705, No.92), known as the Keystone Opportunity Zone, Keystone Opportunity 17 18 Expansion Zone and Keystone Opportunity Improvement Zone Act, is 19 amended by adding a section to read: 20 Section 1105. Prevailing wage. 21 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the act of August
- 22 15, 1961 (P.L.987, No.442), known as the Pennsylvania Prevailing

- 1 Wage Act, shall not apply to a project in a keystone opportunity
- 2 <u>zone for construction, reconstruction or alteration.</u>
- 3 Section 2. The addition of section 1105 of the act shall not
- 4 apply to a contract entered into prior to the effective date of
- 5 this section.
- 6 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
