8	Section 1. Sections 902(b)(4), 903(a)(1) and 904(a)(1) of
9	Title 26 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended
10	to read:
11	§ 902. Moving and related expenses of displaced persons.
12	* * *
13	(b) Damages for dislocation of business or farm operation
14	A displaced person who is displaced from a place of business or
15	from a farm operation shall be entitled, in addition to any
16	payment received under subsection (a), to damages for
17	dislocation of business or farm operation as follows:
18	* * *
19	(4) Actual reasonable expenses necessary to reestablish

a displaced farm, nonprofit organization or small business at
its new site, but not to exceed [\$12,000] <u>\$25,000</u>. Sites
occupied solely by outdoor advertising signs, displays or
devices do not qualify for this benefit.

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6 § 903. Replacement housing for homeowners.

7 (a) Additional payments to certain homeowners.--

8 (1)In addition to payments otherwise authorized, the 9 acquiring agency shall make an additional payment not in 10 excess of [\$27,000] <u>\$31,000</u> to any displaced person who is 11 displaced from a dwelling actually owned and occupied by the 12 displaced person for not less than [180] <u>90</u> days prior to the \blacktriangleleft 13 initiation of negotiations for the acquisition of the 14 property or the receipt of written notice from the acquiring 15 agency of intent to acquire or order to vacate.

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17 § 904. Replacement housing for tenants and others.

18 (a) Payment to certain displaced persons.--

19 In addition to amounts otherwise authorized, an (1)20 acquiring agency shall make a payment to or for any displaced 21 person displaced from a dwelling not eligible to receive a 22 payment under section 903 (relating to replacement housing 23 for homeowners), which dwelling was actually and lawfully 24 occupied by the displaced person for not less than 90 days 25 prior to the initiation of negotiations for acquisition of 26 the dwelling or the receipt of written notice from the 27 acquiring agency of intent to acquire or order to vacate. The 28 payment shall be the amount determined to be necessary to 29 enable the displaced person to lease a comparable replacement 30 dwelling for a period not to exceed 42 months. The amount

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1	shall be the additional amount, if any, over the actual
2	rental or fair rental value of the acquired dwelling, but not
3	more than [\$6,300] <u>\$7,200</u> .

5	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
