AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, in fees, further providing for trucks and truck
3 tractors; and, in inspection of vehicles, further providing
4 for requirement for periodic inspection of vehicles.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 1916(a) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read:

9 § 1916. Trucks and truck tractors.

10 (a) General rule.--

11 \* \* \*

12 (3) A registration fee for a motor carrier vehicle in
13 excess of 17,000 pounds shall be refunded if the vehicle is
14 stolen or demolished. AND THE VEHICLE HAS A NONREPAIRABLE <--
15 CERTIFICATE OR CERTIFICATE OF SALVAGE. THE REFUND SHALL BE
16 PRORATED BASED ON THE NUMBER OF MONTHS THE VEHICLE WAS
17 OPERATIONAL.

1           (4) IN THE CASE OF APPORTIONED REGISTRATIONS, ONLY THE  
2           FEES PAID FOR THE COMMONWEALTH PORTION OF THE FEES SHALL BE  
3           ELIGIBLE FOR A REFUND.

5           Section 2. Section 4702(b)(7) of Title 75 is repealed:

6 § 4702. Requirement for periodic inspection of vehicles.

8           (b) Semiannual safety inspection of certain vehicles.--The  
9 following vehicles shall be subject to semiannual safety  
10 inspection:

12           [(7) Motor carrier vehicles with a registered gross  
13 weight in excess of 17,000 pounds, other than farm vehicles  
14 for which a biennial certificate of exemption has been  
15 issued.]

17           Section 3. This act shall take effect in ~~60~~ 90 days.
