AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, requiring compliance with Federal Selective Service
3 requirements as part of application for learners' permits or
4 drivers' licenses.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

9 § 1521. Compliance with Federal Selective Service requirements.

10 (a) General rule.--Any United States citizen or immigrant
11 who applies for a learner's permit, identification card or
12 driver's license or a renewal of the permit, card or license and
13 who is at least 17 years of age, but less than 26 years of age,
14 must comply with the requirements of section 3 of the Military
15 Selective Service Act (62 Stat. 604, 50 U.S.C. App. § 451 et
16 seq.).

17 (b) Effect of applicant's signature.--The applicant's

1 signature on the application shall serve as an indication that
2 the applicant either has already registered with the Selective
3 Service System or consents to registration if required by
4 Federal law.

5 (c) Notification to applicant.--The department shall place
6 the following statements on the application:

7 (1) By signing this application you are consenting to
8 registration with the Selective Service System, if so
9 required by Federal law. If you are under 18 years of age,
10 you will be registered upon attaining 18 years of age.

11 (2) For applicants who object to conventional military
12 service for religious or other conscientious reasons,
13 alternative service information is available from the
14 Selective Service System's publicly accessible Internet
15 website.

16 (d) The department shall forward, in electronic format to
17 the Selective Service System, the necessary personal information
18 of the applicants required to comply with the Military Selective
19 Service Act.

20 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 180 days.
