## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, requiring compliance with Federal Selective Service
- requirements as part of application for learners' permits or
- 4 drivers' licenses.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 1521. Compliance with Federal Selective Service requirements.
- 10 (a) General rule. -- Any United States citizen or immigrant
- 11 who applies for a learner's permit, identification card or
- 12 <u>driver's license or a renewal of the permit, card or license and</u>
- 13 who is at least 17 years of age, but less than 26 years of age,
- 14 must comply with the requirements of section 3 of the Military
- 15 Selective Service Act (62 Stat. 604, 50 U.S.C. App. § 451 et
- 16 <u>seq.).</u>
- 17 (b) Effect of applicant's signature. -- The applicant's

- 1 signature on the application shall serve as an indication that
- 2 the applicant either has already registered with the Selective
- 3 Service System or consents to registration if required by
- 4 Federal law, unless the applicant affirmatively indicates lack
- 5 of consent by checking the box provided on the application for
- 6 <u>such purpose</u>.
- 7 (c) Notification to applicant. -- The department shall place
- 8 the check-off box required under subsection (b) and the
- 9 <u>following statements on the application:</u>
- 10 (1) By signing this application you are consenting to
- 11 <u>registration with the Selective Service System, if so</u>
- 12 required by Federal law, unless you affirmatively indicate
- 13 <u>your lack of consent by placing a check mark in the box</u>
- 14 provided on this application. If you are under 18 years of
- 15 age, you will be registered upon attaining 18 years of age.
- 16 (1) UNLESS YOU INDICATE YOUR LACK OF CONSENT, YOUR
- 17 SIGNATURE PROVIDES CONSENT TO REGISTRATION WITH THE SELECTIVE

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- 18 SERVICE SYSTEM, IF REQUIRED BY FEDERAL LAW. FAILURE TO
- 19 REGISTER IS A FELONY. IF YOU ARE UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE, YOU
- 20 WILL BE REGISTERED ONCE YOU TURN 18.
- 21 (2) For applicants who object to conventional military
- 22 service for religious or other conscientious reasons,
- 23 alternative service information is available from the
- 24 Selective Service System's publicly accessible Internet
- website.
- 26 (d) Failure to consent.--If the applicant declines to
- 27 consent to registration with the Selective Service System, the
- 28 department may not deny the applicant a license or
- 29 <u>identification card for failure to consent to registration.</u>
- 30 (e) Notification to Selective Service. -- The department shall

- 1 forward, in electronic format to the Selective Service System,
- 2 the necessary personal information of the applicants required to
- 3 <u>comply with the Military Selective Service Act.</u>
- 4 (F) AGREEMENT.--THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT <--
- 5 WITH THE SELECTIVE SERVICE SYSTEM THAT PROVIDES FOR
- 6 REIMBURSEMENT OF THE MOTOR LICENSE FUND BY THE SELECTIVE SERVICE
- 7 SYSTEM FOR THE DEPARTMENT'S ACTUAL COSTS INCURRED IN THE
- 8 DEVELOPMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ELECTRONIC TRANSFER OF
- 9 INFORMATION TO THE SELECTIVE SERVICE SYSTEM. THE AGREEMENT SHALL
- 10 ADDRESS OTHER DETAILS RELATING TO THE DEVELOPMENT AND
- 11 IMPLEMENTATION, AS NECESSARY, INCLUDING THE FREQUENCY OF
- 12 PROVIDING INFORMATION TO THE SELECTIVE SERVICE SYSTEM.
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in <del>180 days</del> SEVEN <--
- 14 MONTHS.
