8	Section 1. Section 484 of the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31,
9	No.21), known as the Public Welfare Code, added December 17,

11	Section 484. Prohibited Use of Public Assistance Funds <u>(a)</u>
12	It shall be unlawful for any individual to [purchase liquor or
13	alcohol with a gift certificate or a gift card which is in the
14	form of] <u>use</u> an electronic benefits card issued to convey public
15	assistance benefits administered by the Department of [Public
16	Welfare] <u>Human Services</u> or a debit card issued to convey support
17	payment moneys[.] <u>to:</u>
18	(1) purchase liquor or alcohol; or
19	(2) deposit funds into an inmate account authorized,

1 administered or maintained by the Department of Corrections or a

2 <u>county correctional institution</u>.

- 3 (b) It shall be unlawful for the Department of Corrections
- 4 or a county correctional institution, or any licensee thereof,
- 5 to allow for the withdrawal of public assistance funds on the
- 6 premises of a correctional institution or, through a point-of-
- 7 sale transaction, to allow public assistance benefits to be
- 8 <u>deposited in violation of this section.</u>
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 180 days.
