Section 8522(b)(5) of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 8 9 § 8522. Exceptions to sovereign immunity. * * * 10 11 Acts which may impose liability .-- The following acts by 12 a Commonwealth party may result in the imposition of liability 13 on the Commonwealth and the defense of sovereign immunity shall 14 not be raised to claims for damages caused by: * * * 15 16 (5) Potholes and other dangerous conditions.--A 17 dangerous condition of highways under the jurisdiction of a Commonwealth agency created by potholes or sinkholes or other 18 19 similar conditions created by natural elements, except that

the claimant to recover must establish that the dangerous

condition created a reasonably foreseeable risk of the kind

of injury which was incurred and that the Commonwealth agency

had actual written notice of the dangerous condition of the

highway a sufficient time prior to the event to have taken

measures to protect against the dangerous condition. Property

damages shall not be recoverable under this paragraph, except

- for motor vehicles operated by a properly licensed driver.
