## AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in sports and amusements, prohibiting the use of drones near stadiums.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
8	<u>§ 7108. Prohibited use of drones near stadiums.</u>
9	(a) General ruleA person may not operate a drone below
10	3,000 feet above and within three miles of a stadium where a
11	sporting event or other public event is occurring in this
12	Commonwealth.
13	(b) ExceptionsThis section shall not apply to the use of
14	a drone by any of the following:
15	(1) a law enforcement agency to counter a high risk of a
16	terrorist attack if the United States Secretary of Homeland
17	Security determines that credible intelligence indicates that
18	there is a risk of a terrorist attack;

1	(2) a law enforcement agency if the law enforcement
2	agency possesses reasonable suspicion that, under particular
3	circumstances, swift action is needed to prevent imminent
4	danger to life or serious damage to property; or
5	(3) an authorized person for operational purposes in
6	connection with a public event in a stadium, including team-
7	sponsored broadcast coverage for the broadcast rights holder,
8	if the person using the drone is otherwise operating in
9	compliance with regulations of the Federal Aviation
10	Administration of the United States Department of
11	Transportation.
12	(c) PenaltyA person who violates this section commits a
13	misdemeanor of the third degree.
14	(d) DefinitionAs used in this section, the term "drone"
15	shall mean a powered, aerial vehicle that:
16	(1) does not carry a human operator;
17	(2) uses aerodynamic forces to provide vehicle lift;
18	(3) can fly autonomously or be piloted remotely;
19	(4) can be expendable or recoverable; and
20	(5) can carry a lethal or nonlethal payload.
21	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
