Amending the act of December 18, 1984 (P.L.1004, No.204), 1 entitled "An act extending benefits to police chiefs or heads 2 of police departments of political subdivisions of the 3 Commonwealth who have been removed from bargaining units by the Pennsylvania Labor Relations Board," providing for fire 5 officers. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. The title of the act of December 18, 1984 10 (P.L.1004, No.204), entitled "An act extending benefits to police chiefs or heads of police departments of political 11 12 subdivisions of the Commonwealth who have been removed from 13 bargaining units by the Pennsylvania Labor Relations Board," is 14 amended to read: 15 AN ACT 16 Extending benefits to police chiefs or heads of police departments and fire chiefs or heads of fire departments of 17 18 political subdivisions of the Commonwealth who have been removed from bargaining units by the Pennsylvania Labor 19

- 2 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 3 <u>Section 1.1. Salary of nonunion fire officers.</u>
- 4 Except in cities of the first and second class, fire chiefs
- 5 and heads of fire departments who have been removed from
- 6 bargaining units under the act of June 24, 1968 (P.L.237,
- 7 No.111), referred to as the Policemen and Firemen Collective
- 8 Bargaining Act, by rulings of the Pennsylvania Labor Relations
- 9 Board shall receive not less than the same dollar increase,
- 10 <u>including fringe benefits but excluding overtime and festive</u>
- 11 holiday pay, as received by the highest ranking fire officer
- 12 participating in the bargaining unit.
- 13 Section 3. This act shall apply retroactively to January 1,
- 14 2016.
- 15 Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
