## AN ACT

- 1 Providing for additional points on civil service examinations 2 for individuals with a disability.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Civil Service
- 7 Employment for Individuals with Disabilities Act.
- 8 Section 2. Definitions.
- 9 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 10 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 11 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- "Individual with a disability." An individual who has a
- 13 disability as defined in section 3 of the Americans with
- 14 Disabilities Act (Public Law 101-336, 42 U.S.C. § 12102) and who
- 15 provides sufficient documentation of the disability to the
- 16 person administering a civil service examination.
- 17 Section 3. Civil service examinations.

- 1 (a) Commonwealth examinations. -- The following shall apply
- 2 for an individual with a disability who successfully passes a
- 3 civil service appointment or promotional examination for a
- 4 public position with the Commonwealth:
- 5 (1) The individual's examination shall be graded an
- 6 additional five points above the grade credited for the
- 7 examination, which shall represent the individual's final
- 8 grade.
- 9 (2) The total grade obtained under paragraph (1) shall
- 10 represent the final grade of the individual and shall
- determine the individual's standing on any appointment or
- 12 promotional list certified or furnished to the appointing or
- 13 promoting power.
- 14 (b) Municipality examinations. -- An examination for
- 15 appointment or promotion in the civil service of a municipality
- 16 taken by an individual with a disability shall be graded or
- 17 marked 5% perfect before the contents or quality of the
- 18 examination is considered.
- 19 Section 4. Effective date.
- This act shall take effect in 60 days.
