Amending the act of July 5, 2012 (P.L.1102, No.132), entitled "An act authorizing the State System of Higher Education and 2 its employees to enter into certain economic development 3 agreements; providing for approval and notice, for reports and for limitations; and making an inconsistent repeal," 5 further providing for title of act, for short title and for 6 7 repeal. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. The title and sections 1 and 8 of the act of July 11 5, 2012 (P.L.1102, No.132), known as the State System of Higher 12 Education Intellectual Property Act, are amended to read: 13 AN ACT 14 Authorizing [the State System of Higher Education and its] 15 State-owned universities and employees of State-owned 16 universities to enter into certain economic development 17 agreements; providing for approval and notice, for reports 18 and for limitations; and making [an] inconsistent [repeal] 19 repeals.
