## AN ACT

- Amending Title 65 (Public Officers) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for training for certain
- 3 appointed officials.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 65 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a chapter to read:
- 8 CHAPTER 15
- 9 TRAINING FOR CERTAIN APPOINTED OFFICIALS

- 4 § 1501. Short title of chapter.
- 5 This chapter shall be known and may be cited as the Training
- 6 for Appointed Officials Act.
- 7 § 1502. Legislative intent.
- 9 promote greater understanding by individuals who are appointed
- 10 to the boards, commissions, authorities or agencies of the
- 11 Commonwealth regarding open records, public proceedings and
- 12 <u>fiduciary responsibilities associated with their government</u>
- 13 service.
- 14 § 1503. Definitions.
- The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 16 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 17 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 18 "Commission." The State Ethics Commission.
- 19 "Commonwealth entity." A board, commission, authority or
- 20 agency of the Commonwealth, whether or not the entity is subject
- 21 to the policy supervision and control of the Governor. The term
- 22 does not include a court or agency of the unified judicial
- 23 system, the General Assembly or its agencies, a State-related
- 24 institution, a political subdivision or a local, regional or
- 25 metropolitan transportation authority.
- 26 "State-related institution." The Pennsylvania State
- 27 <u>University</u>, the <u>University</u> of <u>Pittsburgh</u>, <u>Lincoln University</u> or
- 28 Temple University.
- 29 § 1504. Individuals who must complete training.
- 30 <u>Each individual who is appointed as a member of a</u>

- 1 <u>Commonwealth entity shall complete training under this chapter.</u>
- 2 § 1505. Contents of training.
- 3 Training under this chapter shall include the following
- 4 topics at a minimum:
- 5 (1) The act of February 14, 2008 (P.L.6, No.3), known as
- 6 <u>the Right-to-Know Law.</u>
- 7 (2) Chapter 7 (relating to open meetings).
- 8 (3) Confidential information as defined in section 1102
- 9 <u>(relating to definitions).</u>
- 10 (4) Ethical standards and fiduciary rights and
- 11 <u>responsibilities of an individual appointed as a member of a</u>
- 12 <u>Commonwealth entity.</u>
- 13 <u>(5) The protection of Constitutional rights regarding</u>
- 14 <u>procedures of and matters considered by a Commonwealth</u>
- 15 <u>entity.</u>
- 16 § 1506. When training must be taken.
- 17 Training under this chapter shall be completed as follows:
- 18 (1) For an individual who has been appointed or
- 19 reappointed as a member of a Commonwealth entity on or after
- 20 the effective date of this section, no later than 90 days
- after the appointment or reappointment.
- (2) For an individual who is a member of a Commonwealth
- 23 entity and who was appointed or reappointed to the
- 24 Commonwealth entity before the effective date of this
- 25 section, no later than 120 days after the effective date of
- 26 this section.
- 27 § 1507. Development of training.
- The commission or its designee shall develop and administer
- 29 <u>training under this chapter.</u>
- 30 § 1508. Cost of training.

- 1 The commission shall determine the cost, if any, that an
- 2 <u>individual must pay for training under this chapter.</u>
- 3 § 1509. Failure to complete training.
- 4 (a) General rule. -- Except as provided in subsection (b), an
- 5 <u>individual who does not complete the required training in a</u>
- 6 <u>timely manner under this chapter may not:</u>
- 7 (1) take the oath of office or enter or continue upon
- 8 <u>the duties as a member of the Commonwealth entity; or</u>
- 9 (2) receive compensation from public funds as a member
- of the Commonwealth entity.
- 11 (b) Exception. -- An individual who does not complete the
- 12 required training in a timely manner under this chapter shall be
- 13 given the opportunity to demonstrate good cause to the
- 14 commission as to the reason that the training was not completed
- 15 <u>in a timely manner. If the commission determines that good cause</u>
- 16 exists, it shall waive the penalties under subsection (a) until
- 17 the individual has had a reasonable opportunity to complete the
- 18 training.
- 19 § 1510. Enforcement.
- The commission shall enforce the provisions of this chapter.
- 21 § 1511. Regulations and opinions.
- The commission shall promulgate regulations necessary to
- 23 implement the provisions of this chapter and may issue opinions
- 24 regarding the administration of this chapter.
- 25 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 90 days.
