AN ACT

- Amending the act of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91), entitled 1 "An act providing for a State Lottery and administration 2 thereof; authorizing the creation of a State Lottery 3 Commission; prescribing its powers and duties; disposition of funds; violations and penalties therefor; exemption of prizes 5 from State and local taxation and making an appropriation," 6 in State Lottery, further providing for definitions and for disposition of funds and providing for a compulsive and 8 problem gambling program. 9
- 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 11 hereby enacts as follows:
- 12 Section 1. Section 302 of the act of August 26, 1971
- 13 (P.L.351, No.91), known as the State Lottery Law, is amended by
- 14 adding definitions to read:
- 15 Section 302. Definitions.
- 16 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 17 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 18 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 19 "Compulsive and Problem Gambling Treatment Fund." The fund
- 20 established under 4 Pa.C.S. § 1509 (relating to compulsive and
- 21 problem gambling program).

- 2 "Lottery terminal." A device installed at a retail location
- 3 by the lottery for the purpose of selling and validating on-line
- 4 and instant tickets, performing inventory functions, generating
- 5 informational accounting reports and performing other functions
- 6 <u>at the discretion of the lottery.</u>
- 7 * * *
- 8 Section 2. Section 311(b) of the act, amended November 21,
- 9 1996 (P.L.741, No.134), is amended to read:
- 10 Section 311. Disposition of funds.
- 11 * * *
- 12 (b) Appropriations. -- The moneys in said State Lottery Fund
- 13 shall be appropriated only:
- 14 (1) For the payment of prizes to the holders of winning
- 15 lottery tickets or shares.
- 16 (2) For the expenses of the division in its operation of
- 17 the lottery.
- 18 (3) For property tax relief and free or reduced fare
- transit service for the elderly as provided under subsection
- 20 (a).
- 21 (4) For the compulsive and problem gambling program
- 22 under section 316.
- 23 Section 3. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 24 <u>Section 316.</u> Compulsive and problem gambling program.
- 25 (a) Transfer for compulsive and problem gambling
- 26 treatment. -- Beginning July 1, 2017, and each fiscal year
- 27 thereafter, the sum of \$1,000,000 shall be transferred from the
- 28 State Lottery Fund into the Compulsive and Problem Gambling
- 29 Treatment Fund.
- 30 (b) Establishment of program. -- The Department of Drug and

- 1 Alcohol Programs, in consultation with the secretary, shall
- 2 <u>develop program quidelines for public education, awareness and</u>
- 3 training regarding compulsive and problem gambling and the
- 4 treatment and prevention of compulsive and problem gambling
- 5 specifically regarding play of the lottery. The program shall
- 6 <u>supplement and be complementary to the existing program under 4</u>
- 7 Pa.C.S. § 1509 (relating to compulsive and problem gambling
- 8 program).
- 9 (c) Notice of assistance. -- The secretary shall obtain from
- 10 the Department of Drug and Alcohol Programs a compulsive
- 11 gamblers assistance organization's toll-free problem gambling
- 12 <u>telephone number maintained by the Department of Drug and</u>
- 13 Alcohol Programs. The secretary shall require a statement
- 14 <u>advertising the toll-free telephone number to be conspicuously</u>
- 15 <u>displayed:</u>
- 16 (1) On the front of lottery tickets.
- 17 (2) On one or more signs located near the point of sale
- 18 of lottery tickets sold by lottery sales agents.
- 19 (3) On lottery terminals.
- 20 (4) On merchandising or promotional items for the
- 21 lottery.
- 22 (5) On advertisements for the lottery. In the case of
- 23 radio advertisements, the statement shall be audible.
- 24 (6) On the lottery's Internet website or other social
- 25 media outlet.
- 26 (7) During the televised drawing of lottery numbers.
- 27 <u>(d) Statement.--The statement required to be displayed under</u>
- 28 subsection (c) shall be:
- 29 <u>If you or someone you know has a gambling problem, help is</u>
- 30 available. Call (toll-free telephone number).

- 1 <u>(e) Toll-free telephone number.--The toll-free telephone</u>
- 2 <u>number obtained by the secretary from the Department of Drug and</u>
- 3 Alcohol Programs under subsection (c) shall be the number 1-800-
- 4 GAMBLER, unless the Department of Drug and Alcohol Programs
- 5 <u>determines that the number 1-800-GAMBLER is unavailable for use</u>
- 6 by the lottery.
- 7 Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2017.
