Amending Title TITLES 9 (Burial Grounds) AND 68 (REAL AND 1 <---PERSONAL PROPERTY) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, 2 in general provisions, further providing for definitions and <--3 providing for declaration of policy and for reasonable access-4 for visitation; PROVIDING FOR TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP OF 5 <---CEMETERIES AND FOR REASONABLE ACCESS TO BURIAL GROUNDS; AND, 6 IN SELLER DISCLOSURES, FURTHER PROVIDING FOR DISCLOSURE FORM. 7 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 9 hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 101 of Title 9 of the Pennsylvania 11 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a definition to read: 12 § 101. Definitions. 13 Subject to additional definitions contained in subsequent 14 provisions of this title which are applicable to specific 15 chapters or other provisions of this title, the following words 16 and phrases when used in this title shall have, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, the meanings given to them 17

2	"BURIAL PLOT." A SMALL AREA OF LAND WHERE A PERSON'S BODY	<
3	WILL BE BURIED WHEN THE PERSON DIES. THE PLOT DOES NOT GRANT	
4	OWNERSHIP OF THE LAND BUT DOES GUARANTEE THE RIGHT TO BE BURIED	
5	AT THE LOCATION.

7	"Relative." An individual related to another individual by	<
8	consanguinity, affinity or adoption.	
9	Section 2. Title 9 is amended by adding sections to read:

11	The General Assembly finds and declares as follows:	
12	(1) An individual has a right to reasonable access, for	
13	visitation, to a plot in a cemetery where a relative of the	
14	the individual is buried. This right applies to:

16	<u>(ii) a cemetery owned by a person other than a</u>	
17	<u>cemetery company; and</u>	
18	<u>(iii) a private family cemetery.</u>

22	<u>§ 103. Reasonable access for visitation.</u>	
23	(a) Cemetery companies. A cemetery company shall grant an	
24	individual reasonable access, for visitation, to the plot in its	=

26	(b) Cemeteries not owned by cemetery companies. The owner	
27	<u>of a cemetery not owned by a cemetery company shall grant an</u>	
28	individual reasonable access, for visitation, to the plot in its	Ξ
29	cemetery where a relative of the individual is buried.	

30 <u>(c) Private family cemeteries. The owner of the property</u>

1	where a private family cemetery is located shall grant an
2	individual reasonable access, for visitation, to the plot in the
3	private family cemetery where a relative of the individual is

15	BE NOTIFIED OF ANY CEMETERIES OR GRAVES ON THE PROPERTY IN
16	ACCORDANCE WITH THE FOLLOWING:
17	(1) NOTIFICATION FOR RESIDENTIAL REAL ESTATE IS TO BE IN
18	ACCORDANCE WITH 68 PA.C.S. § 7304(B)(18) (RELATING TO
19	DISCLOSURE FORM) FOR ANY GRAVE SITES ON THE PROPERTY.
20	(2) IF THE PROPERTY IS SUBJECT TO A COMMERCIAL REAL
21	ESTATE TRANSACTION, THE SELLER SHALL INFORM THE PURCHASER OF
22	ANY CEMETERIES OR BURIAL GROUNDS ON THE PROPERTY.

7	Section 3 4. This act shall apply regardless of the date of: <
8	(1) burial; or
9	(2) acquisition of title to the cemetery or private
10	family cemetery.
11	Section 4 5. This act shall take effect in 60 days. <
