AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 1 act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in preliminary provisions, providing 5 for disclosure of student discipline information. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 10 11 section to read:
- 12 <u>Section 126. Disclosure of Student Discipline Information.--</u>
- 13 (a) Upon request, a public school shall disclose information
- 14 <u>concerning the discipline of a student enrolled in the public</u>
- 15 school to appropriate parties other than the student's parent,
- 16 and without the consent of the student's parent or, if the
- 17 <u>student has attained eighteen (18) years of age or is attending</u>
- 18 an institution of postsecondary education, without the consent
- 19 of the student, in connection with an emergency if knowledge of

- 1 the information is necessary to protect the health or safety of
- 2 the student or other individuals, as permitted by the Family
- 3 Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (Public Law 90-247,
- 4 20 U.S.C. § 1232q). For purposes of this section, knowledge of
- 5 <u>information shall be considered necessary to protect the health</u>
- 6 or safety of other individuals when all of the following apply:
- 7 (1) There is an articulable and significant threat to the
- 8 <u>health or safety of the person requesting the disclosure or to</u>
- 9 the child of the person requesting the disclosure.
- 10 (2) Any of the following apply to the student with respect
- 11 to the conduct that is the subject of the request for
- 12 disclosure:
- (i) Initiation of a criminal proceeding in a court of common
- 14 pleas or magisterial district court.
- 15 <u>(ii)</u> Referral to an adult diversion program.
- 16 (iii) Commencement of juvenile delinquency proceedings under
- 17 42 Pa.C.S. § 6321 (relating to commencement of proceedings).
- 18 (iv) Referral for informal adjustment under 42 Pa.C.S. §
- 19 6323(a)(2) (relating to informal adjustment) or a juvenile
- 20 diversion program.
- 21 (b) The recipient of information disclosed under subsection
- 22 (a) shall not disclose such information to any other party.
- 23 (c) Nothing in this section shall be construed to conflict
- 24 with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974.
- 25 (d) As used in this section, the following terms and phrases
- 26 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection, unless
- 27 the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 28 "Information concerning the discipline of a student" shall
- 29 <u>include</u>, but not be limited to, the date on which a suspended or
- 30 expelled student is scheduled to return to school and any

- 1 <u>conditions or restrictions placed on a suspended or expelled</u>
- 2 <u>student upon the student's return to school.</u>
- 3 "Public school" shall mean a school district, charter school,
- 4 cyber charter school, regional charter school, area vocational-
- 5 <u>technical school or intermediate unit.</u>
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
