AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled 1 "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 2 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the 3 Executive Department thereof and the administrative 4 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 5 6 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 7 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 8 9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 10 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 12 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 13 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 14 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 15 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 16 17 and commissions; providing for the regulation of pari-mutuel thoroughbred horse racing and harness horse racing 18 activities, imposing certain taxes and providing for the 19 disposition of funds from pari-mutuel tickets; and 20 prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation 21 of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of 22 23 certain departments, boards and commissions shall be determined," in organization of departmental administrative 24 boards and commissions and of advisory boards and 25 commissions, further providing for Environmental Quality 26 27 Board. 28 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

29 hereby enacts as follows:

30 Section 1. Section 471 of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177,

No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, amended 1 2 November 1, 1979 (P.L.251, No.83), is amended to read: 3 Section 471. Environmental Quality Board.--[The Environmental Quality Board shall consist of the Secretary of 4 Environmental Resources, who shall be chairman thereof, the 5 6 Secretary of Health, the Secretary of Commerce, the Secretary of 7 Transportation, the Secretary of Agriculture, the Secretary of 8 Labor and Industry, the Secretary of Community Affairs, the Executive Director of the Fish Commission, the Executive 9 Director of the Game Commission, the Chairman of the Public 10 Utilities Commission, the Executive Director of the State 11 Planning Board, the Executive Director of the Pennsylvania 12 13 Historical and Museum Commission, five members of the Citizens Advisory Council, and four members of the General Assembly. The 14 15 Citizens Advisory Council members shall be designated by, and 16 serve at the pleasure of, the Citizens Advisory Council. One of the General Assembly members shall be designated by, and serve 17 18 at the pleasure of, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, one by the Minority Leader of the Senate, one by the Speaker of the 19 20 House of Representatives and one by the Minority Leader of the House of Representatives.] (a) The Environmental Quality Board 21

12 (i) The President pro tempore of the Senate.

13 (ii) The Minority Leader of the Senate.

14 (iii) The Speaker of the House of Representatives.

15 (iv) The Minority Leader of the House of Representatives.

16 (13) The chairman and minority chairman of the

17 Environmental Resources and Energy Committee of the Senate.

18 (14) The chairman and minority chairman of the Environmental

19 <u>Resources and Energy Committee of the House of Representatives.</u>

20 (b) In addition to the heads of the various departments as 21 elsewhere in this act provided, the other members of the board 22 may have named alternates to serve in their stead, the alternates for the members of the board from the Citizens 23 24 Advisory Council to be selected by that council from members of 25 the council and each other alternate to be selected by that 26 particular member of the board in whose stead he is to serve. 27 [No person will] A person may not serve as alternate for more 28 than one board member.

29 (c) [Eight] <u>Twelve</u> members of the board shall constitute a 30 quorum.

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1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
