AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, in official inspection stations, providing for
3 notice of safety recall upon inspection.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

8 § 4726.1. Notice of safety recall upon inspection.

9 (a) Safety recall.--Upon conducting a vehicle inspection, an
10 inspection official shall use the vehicle identification number
11 of the inspected vehicle to determine whether the vehicle is
12 subject to a safety recall. If the vehicle is subject to a
13 safety recall, the inspection official shall provide notice of
14 the safety recall to the owner or driver of the vehicle.

15 (b) Certificate of inspection.--An inspection official may
16 not refuse to issue a certificate of inspection under section
17 4727 (relating to issuance of certificate of inspection) to the
18 owner or driver of an inspected vehicle due to a safety recall

1 if the inspected vehicle otherwise meets the inspection criteria
2 required under this chapter.

3 (c) Definition.--As used in this section, the term "safety
4 recall" means a determination by a manufacturer or the National
5 Highway Traffic Safety Administration that a vehicle has a
6 safety-related defect or does not comply with a Federal motor
7 vehicle safety standard.

8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
