## AN ACT

Amending the act of October 27, 2014 (P.L.2911, No.191), 1 entitled "An act providing for prescription drug monitoring; 2 creating the ABC-MAP Board; establishing the Achieving Better Care by Monitoring All Prescriptions Program; and providing for unlawful acts and penalties," further providing for 5 requirements for prescribers. 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 8 9 Section 1. Section 8(a) and (b) of the act of October 27, 2014 (P.L.2911, No.191), known as the Achieving Better Care by 10 11 Monitoring All Prescriptions Program (ABC-MAP) Act, are amended 12 to read: 13 Section 8. Requirements for prescribers. System query. -- A prescriber shall query the system[: 14 15 for each patient [the first] every time the patient 16 is prescribed a controlled substance by the prescriber [for 17 purposes of establishing a baseline and a thorough medical 18 record; or 19 (2) if a prescriber believes or has reason to believe,

- 1 using sound clinical judgment, that a patient may be abusing
- 2 or diverting drugs].
- 3 (b) Medical record entries. -- A prescriber shall indicate the
- 4 information obtained from the system in the patient's medical
- 5 record if[:
- 6 (1) the individual is a new patient; or
- 7 (2)] the prescriber determines a drug should not be
- 8 prescribed or furnished to a patient based upon the
- 9 information from the system.

- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
