- 14 § 3301. Definitions.
- 15 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 16 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 17 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 18 "Abortion." The term shall have the same meaning given to it

- 1 in 18 Pa.C.S. § 3203 (relating to definitions).
- 2 "Complication." The term shall have the same meaning given
- 3 to it in 18 Pa.C.S. § 3203 (relating to definitions).
- 4 "Health insurance exchange." The term shall mean an
- 5 insurance system established to comply with section 1311(b) or
- 6 1321(c) of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act
- 7 (Public Law 111-148, 42 U.S.C. § 18031(b) or 18041(c)).
- 8 § 3302. Opt-out for abortion.
- 9 (a) Prohibition. -- The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby
- 10 elects pursuant to the authority granted the states under
- 11 section 1303(a) of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care
- 12 Act (Public Law 111-148, 42 U.S.C. § 18023(a)) to prohibit
- 13 certain abortion coverage in qualified health plans offered
- 14 through the health insurance exchange under subsection (b).
- 15 (b) Included coverage prohibition. -- No qualified health plan
- 16 offered in this Commonwealth through the health insurance
- 17 exchange shall include coverage for the performance of any
- 18 abortion unless the reason the abortion is performed is one for
- 19 which the expenditure of public funds would be permitted under
- 20 18 Pa.C.S. § 3215(c) (relating to publicly owned facilities;
- 21 public officials and public funds).
- 22 (c) Excluded coverage prohibited. -- No qualified health plan
- 23 offered in this Commonwealth through a health insurance exchange
- 24 shall exclude coverage for:
- 25 (1) Treatment of any postabortion complication.
- 26 (2) Treatment of any miscarriage or any complication
- 27 related to a miscarriage.
- 28 (d) Option. -- Nothing in this section shall prohibit an
- 29 individual from purchasing optional supplemental abortion
- 30 coverage provided the individual pays a separate premium for the

- 1 coverage and obtains the coverage outside of the health
- 2 insurance exchange.]
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
