A RESOLUTION

1 Congratulating the airmen of the 911th Airlift Wing on the  
 2 occasion of Pittsburgh International Airport Reserve Station  
 3 being nominated to compete for the 2015 Commander-in-Chief's  
 4 Annual Award for Installation Excellence.

5 WHEREAS, The Commander-in-Chief's Annual Award for  
 6 Installation Excellence recognizes the top five military  
 7 installations that are most effective at using available  
 8 resources to accomplish their mission and that have demonstrated  
 9 innovative progress in successful installation operations; and

10 WHEREAS, The Pittsburgh International Airport Reserve Station  
 11 (Pittsburgh ARS) was nominated by the Air Force Reserve Command  
 12 for the 2015 Commander-in-Chief's Annual Award for Installation  
 13 Excellence; and

14 WHEREAS, Pittsburgh ARS has represented the command four  
 15 times in the Air Force competition; and

1       WHEREAS, Pittsburgh ARS competed against four other Air Force  
2 Reserve Command host installations for the nomination; and

3       WHEREAS, Pittsburgh ARS's excellence in installation  
4 management, efficiency and effectiveness led to it receiving  
5 Air Force Reserve Command's nomination; and

6       WHEREAS, After receiving the nomination, Pittsburgh ARS will  
7 compete against active duty bases for the distinction of top Air  
8 Force installation; and

9       WHEREAS, The distinction of top Air Force installation comes  
10 with a prize of \$1 million which can be used for morale, welfare  
11 and recreation purposes; and

12       WHEREAS, In addition to receiving the nomination, Pittsburgh  
13 ARS has also won multiple awards from the Air Force Reserve  
14 Command throughout the past year; and

15       WHEREAS, With excellence in installation efficiency and  
16 effectiveness, Pittsburgh ARS is a great source of pride to the  
17 City of Pittsburgh and the Commonwealth; therefore be it

18       RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives congratulate the  
19 airmen of the 911th Airlift Wing on the occasion of Pittsburgh
