A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and ultimate sacrifice of Lieutenant Joyce
- 2 Craig, a Philadelphia firefighter who lost her life in the
- line of duty, and expressing condolences upon her passing.
- 4 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Joyce Craig, a decorated Philadelphia
- 5 firefighter, tragically lost her life in the line of duty on
- 6 December 9, 2014, at the age of 37; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Craig was born on June 7, 1977, and as a
- 8 child dreamed of committing her life to public service by
- 9 becoming a firefighter; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Craig graduated from Philadelphia's
- 11 Murrell Dobbins Vocational High School in 1995 and began
- 12 achieving her dreams by subsequently earning her EMT
- 13 certification; and

- 1 WHEREAS, On December 8, 2003, Lieutenant Craig entered the
- 2 Philadelphia Fire Academy as a member of the 178th Cadet class
- 3 and graduated on March 26, 2004; and
- 4 WHEREAS, During her 11 years of dedicated service at the
- 5 Philadelphia Fire Department, Lieutenant Craig served at Engine
- 6 9 and Ladder 21 in Mount Airy, Engine 45 in North Philadelphia
- 7 and one of the busiest companies in Philadelphia, Engine 64 in
- 8 Lawncrest; and
- 9 WHEREAS, A decorated first responder, Lieutenant Craig was
- 10 revered for her hard work, bravery and professionalism and
- 11 heralded by Philadelphia Fire Commissioner Derrick Sawyer as a
- 12 "firefighter's firefighter"; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Craig and colleagues from Engine 69
- 14 Platoon "C" received a Unit Citation for their efforts in
- 15 rescuing two adults from a house fire in September 2007; and
- 16 WHEREAS, On Tuesday, December 9, 2014, Lieutenant Craig
- 17 tragically lost her life responding to a fire at a home in the
- 18 West Oak Lane section of Philadelphia; and
- 19 WHEREAS, True to her strong work ethic and commitment to her
- 20 profession, Lieutenant Craig was working an overtime shift for
- 21 Engine 73 on the day of her passing and assisted with the rescue
- 22 of an elderly resident while battling the fire; and
- WHEREAS, One of only 165 women among approximately 2,158
- 24 members of the Philadelphia Fire Department at the time of her
- 25 passing, Lieutenant Craig was the first female firefighter to
- 26 die in the line of duty in Philadelphia; and
- 27 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Craig was posthumously awarded the rank
- 28 of Lieutenant in recognition of her heroism, passion for
- 29 firefighting and outstanding service to the residents of
- 30 Philadelphia; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Craig is survived by her deeply beloved
- 2 16-year-old son and 16-month-old daughter; therefore be it
- 3 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives honor the life
- 4 and ultimate sacrifice of Lieutenant Joyce Craig and express
- 5 most sincere condolences to her family, friends and colleagues
- 6 upon her passing; and be it further
- 7 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be transmitted to
- 8 the family of Lieutenant Joyce Craig.
