4	WHEREAS, The Department of Transportation has an established
5	policy as to the type of identification required for a change of
6	name to a driver's license or identification card; and
7	WHEREAS, An individual who adopts the surname of her spouse
8	is only required to provide a copy of the couple's marriage
9	certificate to obtain a change of name on her noncommercial
10	driver's license or identification card; and
11	WHEREAS, In contrast, an individual who adopts the surname of
12	her spouse and retains her former surname as a middle name must
13	provide a copy of the individual's Social Security card,
14	together with copies of documents from two other sources issued
15	in the desired name, such as tax records, Selective Service
16	card, voter registration card, passport, photo identification

issued by a governmental agency or state-issued birth

- 2 WHEREAS, Individuals who retain their former surnames find it
- 3 difficult to obtain the additional required documentation; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Requiring this additional documentation constitutes
- 5 an unfair and unreasonable practice by the Department of
- 6 Transportation; therefore be it
- 7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge the
- 8 Department of Transportation to change its policy of requiring <--
