A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing Magee Rehabilitation Hospital on its 57th
- anniversary of providing specialized health care services to
- the residents of Pennsylvania and beyond.
- 4 WHEREAS, Opened in March, 1958, Magee Rehabilitation Hospital
- 5 is the oldest rehabilitation hospital in Philadelphia and is
- 6 located in Center City Philadelphia, at 1513 Race Street,
- 7 adjacent to Interstate 676 and in close proximity to Interstate
- 8 95 and Interstate 76; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Magee Rehabilitation Hospital is a 96-bed, nonprofit
- 10 hospital providing state-of-the-art rehabilitation treatment
- 11 therapies and medical care to individuals who have experienced
- 12 traumatic injury and illnesses such as spinal cord injury, brain
- 13 injury, stroke, amputation and other neurological disorders and
- 14 diseases; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Magee Rehabilitation Hospital employs 629 staff
- 16 members who collectively provide advanced, highly skilled

- 1 medical and rehabilitation therapies to 4,500 patients annually;
- 2 and
- 3 WHEREAS, Many of Magee Rehabilitation Hospital's patients are
- 4 economically disadvantaged and struggle to meet their basic
- 5 needs; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Twenty-six percent of inpatients and 49% of
- 7 outpatients at Magee Rehabilitation Hospital are eligible for
- 8 medical assistance and are deemed low income; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Magee Rehabilitation Hospital offers innovative
- 10 programs such as the Vision Clinic at Magee, dedicated to the
- 11 treatment and recovery from the ill-effects of visual impairment
- 12 as a result of brain injury, and the Philadelphia Concussion
- 13 Center, dedicated to the treatment and recovery from the ill
- 14 effects of concussion; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Magee Rehabilitation Hospital is consistently
- 16 recognized as one of the United States News and World Report
- 17 Best Hospitals and is accredited by the Joint Commission on
- 18 Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations and the Commission on
- 19 Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Magee Rehabilitation Hospital was the first facility
- 21 in the nation to be accredited in brain injury rehabilitation;
- 22 and
- 23 WHEREAS, Magee Rehabilitation Hospital is a founding member
- 24 of the Christopher and Dana Reeve Foundation's NeuroRecovery
- 25 Network and is at the forefront of treatment for people living
- 26 with spinal cord injuries, currently studying improvements to
- 27 the way facilities the world over treat spinal cord injuries and
- 28 their secondary complications; therefore be it
- 29 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize Magee
- 30 Rehabilitation Hospital on its 57th anniversary of providing

- 1 specialized health care services and congratulate it for its
- 2 dedication, commitment and distinguished service to the health
- 3 care needs of the residents of this Commonwealth and beyond.
