## A RESOLUTION

1 Designating April 13, 2015, as "Lineman's Appreciation Day" in  
2 Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, America's electric cooperatives have designated the  
4 second Monday of April as "National Lineman Appreciation Day" to  
5 honor the hard work of electric linemen; and

6 WHEREAS, Linemen leave their families and risk their lives  
7 every day to keep the power on; and

8 WHEREAS, Linemen work 365 days a year under dangerous  
9 conditions to build, maintain and repair the electric  
10 infrastructure; and

11 WHEREAS, Linemen working for rural electric cooperatives  
12 maintain 2,566,917 miles of distribution line for 850  
13 distribution systems nationwide; and

14 WHEREAS, Linemen are the first responders of the electric  
15 cooperative family, restoring power and making conditions safe

1 for all after storms and accidents; and

2 WHEREAS, There would be no electric cooperatives without the  
3 brave men and women who comprise the corps of linemen; therefore  
4 be it

5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate April  
6 13, 2015, as "Lineman's Appreciation Day" in Pennsylvania.
