- Recognizing Pennsylvania Cystic Fibrosis, Inc., for its extraordinary efforts over the past 30 years in raising awareness of cystic fibrosis, providing support and financial
- 4 assistance to affected families and supporting progressive
- 5 research for a cure.
- 6 WHEREAS, Cystic fibrosis (CF) is the most common fatal
- 7 genetic disease; and
- 8 WHEREAS, CF causes severe damage to the lungs and digestive
- 9 system; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Founded on October 2, 1985, Pennsylvania Cystic
- 11 Fibrosis, Inc., (PACFI), an independent, nonprofit volunteer
- 12 organization, provides services and supports for individuals and
- 13 families affected by CF throughout this Commonwealth and funds
- 14 some of the nation's most progressive research; and
- 15 WHEREAS, PACFI's financial assistance provides air
- 16 conditioners, portable nebulizers, generators, CF-related

- 1 equipment, medications, transplant expenses not covered by
- 2 insurance, scholarships for individuals with CF who want to
- 3 continue their education and educational books about CF for
- 4 families; and
- 5 WHEREAS, PACFI supports clinics at Geisinger Medical Center,
- 6 Penn State Hershey Medical Center, Children's Hospital of
- 7 Philadelphia and the University of Pittsburgh Medical Center;
- 8 and
- 9 WHEREAS, PACFI offers advocacy and educational materials for
- 10 parents of students with CF who are having problems at school
- 11 and assists families by funding various emergency expenses; and
- 12 WHEREAS, PACFI has supported oral glutathione (GSH) research
- 13 in CF since 2004 through the Utah Valley Institute of Cystic
- 14 Fibrosis; and
- 15 WHEREAS, A 2015 study supported by PACFI shows that GSH
- 16 significantly improves measures of growth in children and
- 17 reduces gut inflammation; and
- 18 WHEREAS, PACFI received the President's Club Award in 2010
- 19 from the University of Minnesota, one of the nation's best CF
- 20 care centers, for supporting Dr. Toni Moran's CF-related
- 21 diabetes research; and
- 22 WHEREAS, PACFI has supported CF research at Hahnemann
- 23 University, University of Pennsylvania, University of
- 24 Pittsburgh, University of Vermont, University of California at
- 25 San Francisco, University of Virginia and Michigan State
- 26 University; and
- 27 WHEREAS, Boyds Bears named a special teddy bear in its fall
- 28 1997 collection "Burke P. Bear" after Burke Derr, a child who
- 29 collected teddy bears and who died from CF on June 17, 1997; and
- 30 WHEREAS, In 1999, Burke P. Bear was proclaimed the

- 1 Pennsylvania Ambassador for love, peace, fun and a cure for
- 2 cystic fibrosis; and
- 3 WHEREAS, More than 134 retailers of Boyds Bears in
- 4 Pennsylvania, 30 other states and Canada donate \$1 from every
- 5 Burke P. Bear sold to PACFI for its Million Dollar Bear
- 6 campaign; and
- WHEREAS, Burke P. Bear has toured 23 countries and all 50
- 8 states since 1997 and, in collaboration with Cystic Fibrosis
- 9 Worldwide, has helped to create an international awareness of CF
- 10 in addition to raising funds; and
- 11 WHEREAS, PACFI has raised more than \$565,000 for CF research
- 12 through its Million Dollar Bear campaign, Burke P. Bear's tour
- 13 and donations; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Burke P. Bear received Certificates of Merit from
- 15 the United States House of Representatives, the Massachusetts
- 16 State Senate, the City of Lubbock, Texas, and the City of
- 17 Auburn, Massachusetts, for his CF work and has been dubbed by a
- 18 British publication as the "Globe-trotting Ambassador of Love";
