## A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing the observance of the Holy Month of Ramadan, a month 1
- of reflection and prayer for the Muslim community, which runs from June 18 through July 17, 2015, and the festival of Eid 2 3
- al-Fitr. 4
- 5 WHEREAS, Millions of Americans practice Islam; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The Muslim-American population is an extraordinary
- 7 mosaic of ethnic, linguistic, ideological, social, economic and
- 8 religious groups; and
- 9 WHEREAS, In representation of the ninth month of the Islamic
- 10 calendar, Ramadan was established as a Holy Month for the people
- of the Muslim faith; and 11
- 12 WHEREAS, The Holy Month of Ramadan is celebrated each year
- 13 based on the visual sightings of the crescent moon, as the time
- the Quran was revealed to the Prophet Muhammad on the occasion 14
- 15 known as Laylat al-Qadr, the Night of Power; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Observers celebrate the ritual fast, known as Sawm,
- 17 one of the five pillars of Islam, by fasting from dusk till
- 18 dawn, experiencing hunger and thirst as a means of becoming more
- sympathetic, pious and charitable; and 19

- 1 WHEREAS, Participants during Ramadan devote themselves to
- 2 reflection and the reading of the Quran, the purification of the
- 3 soul and the practice of self-sacrifice; and
- 4 WHEREAS, During the Holy Month of Ramadan, Muslims focus
- 5 fully on devotion and service to God, purging themselves of
- 6 impure thoughts and motivations which are counter to Islam; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The faithful gather in celebration of Eid al-Fitr,
- 8 the Festival of Fast Breaking, at the end of the Holy Month of
- 9 Ramadan, one of the most important holidays in the Muslim world,
- 10 marked with prayer, family reunions and the sharing of generous
- 11 evening meals; therefore be it
- 12 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 13 observance of the Holy Month of Ramadan, a month of reflection
- 14 and prayer for the Muslim community, which runs from June 18
- 15 through July 17, 2015, and the festival of Eid al-Fitr.
