- States Marine Corps Reserve (USMCR), and adopted by the United
- States Marine Corps (USMC) in 1948, the Toys for Tots Program
- has been the recipient of numerous awards, including a 4-star
- 10 rating by Charity Navigator, and inclusion in Forbes' "Gold
- 11 Star" list of charities and various other accolades; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The USMCR Toys for Tots Program is directed by the
- 13 USMCR Commander from the USMCR Headquarters in New Orleans,
- 14 Louisiana; and

- 1 WHEREAS, The mission of the USMCR Toys for Tots Program is to
- 2 collect new, unwrapped toys during the months of October,
- 3 November and December each year and to distribute those toys as
- 4 Christmas gifts to less fortunate children in the community in
- 5 which the campaign is conducted; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The Marine Toys for Tots Foundation, an Internal
- 7 Revenue Service recognized 501(c)(3) not-for-profit charity, is
- 8 the authorized fundraising and support organization for the
- 9 USMCR Toys for Tots Program; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The Marine Toys for Tots Foundation, located just
- 11 outside the main gate of the Marine Corps Base in Quantico,
- 12 Virginia, provides the funding and support needed for successful
- 13 annual toy collection and distribution campaigns; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The Marine Toys for Tots Foundation was created at
- 15 the behest of the USMC and provides support in accordance with a
- 16 Memorandum of Understanding with the USMCR Commander; and
- 17 WHEREAS, The Marine Toys for Tots Foundation has supported
- 18 the USMCR Toys for Tots Program since 1991; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Local campaigns are conducted annually in over 700
- 20 communities covering all 50 states, the District of Columbia and
- 21 Puerto Rico; and
- 22 WHEREAS, Over its life span, the USMCR Toys for Tots Program
- 23 has distributed over 494 million toys to over 230 million less
- 24 fortunate children; therefore be it
- 25 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives congratulate the
- 26 USMCR Toys for Tots Program and the Marine Toys for Tots
- 27 Foundation on their continued efforts to provide a message of
- 28 hope to less fortunate children that will assist them in
