A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the Carbon Career and Technical Institute for its
2 success in receiving the highest score from among all career
3 and technical schools in this Commonwealth on the
4 Pennsylvania School Performance Profile for the second
5 consecutive year.

6 WHEREAS, There are 18 comprehensive career and technical
7 schools in this Commonwealth; and

8 WHEREAS, The career and technical schools are annually
9 evaluated by the Department of Education of the Commonwealth for
10 academic progress through the Pennsylvania School Performance
11 Profile; and

12 WHEREAS, Recently the Department of Education released the
13 Pennsylvania School Performance Profile for career and technical
14 schools as to the 2014-2015 school year; and

15 WHEREAS, For that school year, the Carbon Career and
16 Technical Institute received on the Pennsylvania School
17 Performance Profile an academic score of 88.4, which was a

1 significant increase from 79.2 during the prior year; and

2 WHEREAS, For the second consecutive year, the academic score
3 received by the Carbon Career and Technical Institute on the
4 Pennsylvania School Performance Profile was the highest academic
5 score of any other career and technical school in this
6 Commonwealth; therefore be it

7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
8 Carbon Career and Technical Institute for its success in
9 receiving on the Pennsylvania School Performance Profile, for
10 the second consecutive year, the highest score from among all
11 career and technical schools in this Commonwealth.
