A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the bicentennial of the City of Pittsburgh.
- 2 WHEREAS, On March 12, 1816, the General Assembly passed a law
- 3 to incorporate Pittsburgh, which at the time had a population
- 4 between 5,000 and 6,000 residents; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The City of Pittsburgh will kick off the celebration
- 6 of the 200th anniversary of the incorporation as a city on March
- 7 18, 2016, with an Incorporation Day event at the City-County
- 8 Building; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The event will acknowledge innovations that created
- 10 mighty industries and world class medical and educational
- 11 facilities and recognize the severe economic challenges the
- 12 residents have faced and overcome; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The celebration will feature guest speakers, musical
- 14 performances, artwork created by local students, historical
- 15 artifacts from dozens of Pittsburgh institutions and the
- 16 unveiling of the original City Charter document on loan from the

- 1 Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission; and
- 2 WHEREAS, City volunteers are still searching for the time
- 3 capsule that Mayor Joseph Armstrong placed in the City-County
- 4 Building on May 18, 1916, and the city and Bicentennial
- 5 Commission hope to have a time capsule update on Incorporation
- 6 Day; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The city will continue to celebrate its bicentennial
- 8 with a Bicentennial Bash at the Heinz History Center on July 8,
- 9 2016, and an Anniversary Celebration on July 9, 2016; therefore
- 10 be it
- 11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 12 bicentennial of the City of Pittsburgh.
