A RESOLUTION

1 2	Recognizing the month of May 2016 as "Melanoma and Skin Cancer Detection and Prevention Month" in Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, Most people do not realize that the skin is the
4	largest and most visible organ of the body and performs many
5	essential tasks, such as regulating body temperature, protecting
6	internal organs, providing sensation and supporting metabolic
7	functions; and
8	WHEREAS, According to current estimates, one in five
9	Americans will develop skin cancer in their lifetime; and
10	WHEREAS, More than 2 million cases of nonmelanoma skin cancer
11	are diagnosed in the United States each year; and
12	WHEREAS, Recent estimates show there will be 123,590 new
13	cases of melanoma, the deadliest form of skin cancer, diagnosed

1 in the United States each year; and

2 WHEREAS, Melanoma is the most common form of cancer for young 3 adults between 25 and 29 years of age and the second most common 4 form of cancer for adolescents and young adults between 15 and 5 29 years of age; and

6 WHEREAS, The estimated total direct cost associated with the 7 treatment of melanoma in 2010 was \$2.36 billion; and

8 WHEREAS, Melanoma and other skin cancers are highly treatable 9 if detected early; and

10 WHEREAS, Sun exposure is the most preventable risk factor for 11 all skin cancers, including melanoma; therefore be it 12 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the 13 month of May 2016 as "Melanoma and Skin Cancer Detection and 14 Prevention Month" in Pennsylvania.
