## A RESOLUTION

Designating the week of May 22 through 28, 2016, as "Women's Lung Health Week" in Pennsylvania.
WHEREAS, According to the American Lung Association, every
five minutes a woman in the United States is told she has lung cancer; and

WHEREAS, Lung cancer is the deadliest cancer of both and men women in the United States; and

WHEREAS, While the lung cancer death rate among men has fallen $21 \%$ in the last 35 years, it has increased $116 \%$ among women; and

WHEREAS, The lung cancer death rate in women has almost doubled over the past 37 years; and

WHEREAS, Lung cancer must be a national priority due to the highest incidence rate and one of the lowest survival rates; and WHEREAS, Advocacy and increased awareness will result in more

5 women's awareness of lung cancer as the deadliest cancer and
