A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of June 2016 as "Adopt a Cat Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, The American Humane Association and other
- 4 organizations devoted to animal welfare acknowledge that
- 5 thousands of newborn kittens join the millions of cats in animal
- 6 shelters nationwide each spring; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Shelters, animal control facilities, animal rescue
- 8 organizations, veterinarians, philanthropists and donors as well
- 9 as potential adopters all have a stake in finding good homes for
- 10 these animals; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Of the estimated 3.4 million cats entering animal
- 12 shelters nationwide each year, 1.3 million are adopted and 1.4
- 13 million are euthanized; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Approximately 42.9 million homes in the United
- 15 States have at least one cat; and
- 16 WHEREAS, When considering adoption, all persons living in a

- 2 WHEREAS, When a pet is given as a gift, the recipient should
- 3 participate in the adoption process; and
- 4 WHEREAS, All pets living in a home should be properly
- 5 introduced and socialized; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Appropriate veterinary care is essential; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Bonding with companion animals has long provided
- 8 valuable physiological, psychological and social benefits for
- 9 animal owners and caregivers; therefore be it
- 10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 11 month of June 2016 as "Adopt a Cat Month" in Pennsylvania.
