A RESOLUTION

- Designating July 28, 2016, as "Hail to Pitt Day" in Pennsylvania in recognition of the 50th anniversary of the University of
- 3 Pittsburgh becoming a State-related university.
- WHEREAS, On July 28, 1966, Governor William W. Scranton
- 5 signed the bill establishing the University of Pittsburgh as a
- 6 State-related university; and
- WHEREAS, The University of Pittsburgh's 34,826 students are
- 8 among Pennsylvania's best and brightest, coming from the top of
- 9 their classes, performing groundbreaking research and providing
- 10 thousands of hours of service to the community; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The University of Pittsburgh is a major economic
- 12 driver for this Commonwealth, employing more than 13,000 people,
- 13 supporting more than 33,800 jobs and generating a Statewide
- 14 economic impact of \$3.7 billion; and
- 15 WHEREAS, For each dollar invested in the University of
- 16 Pittsburgh, this Commonwealth receives a \$25 return on the
- 17 investment; and
- 18 WHEREAS, The University of Pittsburgh is a driving force of

- 1 innovation, generating 74 patents in 2014, launching 117
- 2 startups in the last 20 years and raising \$14 million for local
- 3 business in 2014; and
- 4 WHEREAS, The University of Pittsburgh is continually ranked
- 5 the top value among all Pennsylvania public colleges and
- 6 universities, named a "Best Value College" and lauded for its
- 7 contributions to the community; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Employees and students of the University of
- 9 Pittsburgh generate more than \$70 million annually in charitable
- 10 donations and volunteer services; therefore be it
- 11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate July
- 12 28, 2016, as "Hail to Pitt Day" in Pennsylvania in recognition
- 13 of the 50th anniversary of the University of Pittsburgh becoming
- 14 a State-related institution; and be it further
- 15 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives encourage all
- 16 Pennsylvanians to acknowledge the immense value the University
- 17 of Pittsburgh and its faculty, staff, students and alumni bring
- 18 to this Commonwealth.
