10	WHEREAS, Women In Bio-Pittsburgh is a nonprofit organization
11	working to support recognized and emerging women leaders in the
12	life sciences of western Pennsylvania, eastern Ohio and West
13	Virginia; and
14	WHEREAS, Women In Bio-Pittsburgh's mission is to promote

entrepreneurship, innovation, education and mentorship among
 women across the region by providing programming and networking
 opportunities; and

4 WHEREAS, Women In Bio-Pittsburgh is committed to increasing 5 the impact of local women on the growth of the region by 6 supporting their careers and professional development in the 7 life sciences; and
