## A RESOLUTION

- Designating October 20, 2016, as "Lights on Afterschool Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, More than 28 million children in the United States
- 4 have parents who work outside the home, and more than 15 million
- 5 children are left unsupervised after the school bell rings; and
- 6 WHEREAS, After school programs provide safe, challenging,
- 7 engaging and fun learning experiences to help children and
- 8 youths develop academic, cultural, emotional, physical and
- 9 social skills; and
- 10 WHEREAS, After school programs support working families by
- 11 ensuring that their children are safe and productive during out-
- 12 of-school hours; and
- 13 WHEREAS, After school programs provide for a fun and
- 14 supportive educational environment for Science, Technology,
- 15 Engineering and Mathematics (STEM); and
- 16 WHEREAS, A recent national survey found that 52% of parents

- 1 cite cost as a barrier to enrolling their children in after
- 2 school programs; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Approximately 811,954 students in Pennsylvania would
- 4 participate in an afterschool program if one were available to
- 5 them; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Research illustrates that high-quality programming
- 7 improves student achievement, reduces crime by and against
- 8 children and youths and promotes positive social development;
- 9 and
- 10 WHEREAS, After school programs build stronger communities by
- 11 involving parents, business leaders and student and youth
- 12 volunteers in the lives of our young people, thereby promoting
- 13 positive relationships among children, youths, families and
- 14 adults; and
- 15 WHEREAS, "Lights on Afterschool Day," a national celebration
- 16 of after school programs held on October 20, 2016, promotes the
- 17 critical importance of quality after school programs in the
- 18 lives of children, their families and their communities;
- 19 therefore be it
- 20 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate October
- 21 20, 2016, as "Lights on Afterschool Day" in Pennsylvania.
