| 10          | (a) Duty to provide disclosure  |
| 11          | (1) Prior to the execution of a gas mineral rights lease  |
| 12          | agreement, the gas drilling company shall disclose to the   |
| 13          | landowner that the landowner may be liable to other   |
| 14          | landowners for damages that result from the gas drilling.   |
| 15          | (2) The disclosure shall be on a separate piece of  |
| 16          | paper, in ten-point all capital type and shall include a  |
| 17          | statement that the landowner should consult an attorney   |
| 18          | before signing any document relating to a gas mineral rights  |

- 1 lease agreement.
- 2 (3) The disclosure shall be signed by the landowner
- 3 prior to or simultaneously with the execution of the
- 4 <u>agreement.</u>
- 5 (b) Departmental approval required. -- The department shall
- 6 approve the form and content of the disclosure statement
- 7 required under subsection (a).
- 8 (c) Indemnification provision required. -- A gas mineral
- 9 rights lease agreement shall contain an indemnification
- 10 provision that holds the landowner harmless from any and all
- 11 liability, liens, claims and environmental liability arising out
- 12 of the drilling company's operations under the terms of the
- 13 lease.
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
