AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, in minors, further providing for
3 misrepresentation of age to secure liquor or malt or brewed
4 beverages, for purchase, consumption, possession or
5 transportation of liquor or malt or brewed beverages and for
6 carrying a false identification card.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. Section 6307(b) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
10 Consolidated Statutes is amended and the section is amended by
11 adding a subsection to read:

12 § 6307. Misrepresentation of age to secure liquor or malt or
13 brewed beverages.

15 (b) Minimum penalty.--In addition to any other penalty
16 imposed pursuant to subsection (b.1), section 6310.4 (relating
17 to restriction of operating privileges) or this title or other
18 statute, a person who is convicted of violating subsection (a)
19 may be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$500 for the
20 first violation and not more than \$1,000 for subsequent

1 violations. No court shall have the authority to suspend any
2 sentence as defined in this section.

3 (b.1) Community service.--A person convicted of violating
4 subsection (a) shall be sentenced to not more than 40 hours of
5 community service for a first violation and not more than 100
6 hours of community service for a second or subsequent violation.

8 Section 2. Section 6308(b) of Title 18 is amended and the
9 section is amended by adding a subsection to read:

10 § 6308. Purchase, consumption, possession or transportation of
11 liquor or malt or brewed beverages.

13 (b) Penalty.--In addition to the [penalty] penalties imposed
14 pursuant to subsection (b.1) and section 6310.4 (relating to
15 restriction of operating privileges), a person convicted of
16 violating subsection (a) may be sentenced to pay a fine of not
17 more than \$500 for the first violation and not more than \$1,000
18 for the second and each subsequent violation.

19 (b.1) Community service.--A person convicted of violating
20 subsection (a) shall be sentenced to not more than 40 hours of
21 community service for a first violation and not more than 100
22 hours of community service for a second or subsequent violation.

24 Section 3. Section 6310.3(b) of Title 18 is amended and the
25 section is amended by adding a subsection to read:

26 § 6310.3. Carrying a false identification card.

28 (b) Minimum penalty.--In addition to any other penalty
29 imposed pursuant to subsection (b.1), section 6310.4 (relating
30 to restriction of operating privileges) or any other statute, a

1 person who is convicted of violating subsection (a) shall be
2 sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$500 for the first
3 violation and not more than \$1,000 for the second and subsequent
4 violations. No court shall have the authority to suspend any
5 sentence as defined in this section.

6 (b.1) Community service.--A person convicted of violating
7 subsection (a) shall be sentenced to not more than 40 hours of
8 community service for a first violation and not more than 100
9 hours of community service for a second or subsequent violation.

11 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
